## — COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS —

- Converted WR who recorded 172 carries for 858 yards and 10 TDs, adding 84 receptions for 787 yards and 5 receiving TDs over 50 career games (20 starts) with Clemson
- Also credited with 13 career KORs for 302 yards (23.2 avg.), including a memorable 41-yard return in the 2024 ACC Championship Game to help set up Clemson's game-winning FG
- Is the fourth player in Clemson history to reach 750 career rushing yards and 750 career receiving yards, joining Travis Zachery, C.J. Spiller and Travis Etienne

## — PERSONAL —

- Became the first Ravens draft pick ever selected directly by team owner Steve Bisciotti in 2025
- Earned his bachelor's degree in management (December 2024) in only three years at Clemson... Added a master's degree in athletic leadership in December 2025
- Participated in P.A.W. Journey's service trip to South Africa in spring 2024
- From the same area in South Carolina that produced former Tiger and current NFL receiver Hunter Renfrow
- Dedicated community servant named to the 2025 AFCA Good Works Team

## — NOTE THE QUOTE —

"Adam has a varied skillset. He does a lot of different things well. We think the best is yet to come with him as a running back. He has really good hands. He can run routes. ## 2025: (CLEMSON – 13/13)

- Permanently transitioned to RB in the offseason... Rushed 168 times for 813 yards and 10 TDs, also catching 36 passes for 254 yards with 3 receiving TDs in 612 offensive snaps... Added 9 KORs for 213 yards for a season total of 1,281 all-purpose yards
- Rushed 11 times for 35 yards and his 10th rushing TD of the season vs. Penn State (12/27) in the Pinstripe Bowl
- Rushed a career-high 24 times for 102 yards with a rushing TD and caught a 2-point conversion at South Carolina (11/29)
- Rushed 15 times for 105 yards with a career-high-tying 2 TDs... Added 3 receptions for 27 yards at No. 19 Louisville (11/8)
- Rushed 16 times for 89 yards with a career-high 2 rushing TDs vs. Duke (11/1)
- Rushed 10 times for 36 yards with a TD at Boston College (10/11), becoming the first Clemson player to score a TD in each of the first six games of a season since Travis Etienne in 2018
- Rushed 8 times for 30 yards and caught 4 passes for a career-high 73 receiving yards and a career-high 2 receiving TDs at North Carolina (10/4), becoming the first Clemson RB to catch 2 TDs in a single game since Travis Etienne in the 2019 Fiesta Bowl against Ohio State
- Accrued 16 carries for 130 yards, a career-high 7 receptions for 44 yards with a receiving TD, plus 53 KOR yards for a career-high total of 227 all-purpose yards vs. Syracuse (9/20), becoming the first Clemson player to record 200 all-purpose yards since Will Shipley's 242 yards vs. Syracuse in 2022
- Rushed 15 times for a team-high 80 yards with a TD at Georgia Tech (9/13), including a 30-yard conversion on third-and-22 on Clemson's first scoring drive
- Recorded his first-career 100-yard rushing game vs. Troy (9/6), carrying 21 times for 112 yards and a TD amid his 165 all-purpose yards

## 2024: (CLEMSON – 12/1)

- Recorded 16 catches for 155 yards, rushed 4 times for 44 yards and returned 3 KORs for 74 yards... Played 242 offensive snaps
- Contributed at RB at No. 3 Texas (12/21) in the CFP first-round playoff, recording a career-long 41-yard rush
- Recorded one of the biggest plays of Clemson's dramatic ACC Championship Game win vs. No. 8 SMU (12/7), returning a KO a career-long 41 yards to put Clemson in range to complete a pass and set up Nolan Hauser's game-winning walkoff 56-yard FG
- Caught 3 passes for 19 yards, including a 9-yard TD reception, at Wake Forest (10/12)

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- Caught 4 passes for 31 yards vs. Appalachian State (9/7)
- Led Clemson with a then-career-high 69 receiving yards and added his first-career TD reception on his 5 catches vs. NC State (8/31)

### 2023: (CLEMSON – 13/5)

- Recorded 22 receptions for 250 yards in 466 snaps over 13 games (five starts)
- Gained 46 yards on a then-career-high 5 receptions in the Gator Bowl vs. Kentucky (12/29)
- Posted a then-career-high and team-high 53 receiving yards on 2 receptions vs. No. 20 North Carolina (11/18)
- Gained 23 yards on 3 receptions at NC State (10/28)
- Posted a career-long 34-yard reception at Miami (10/21)
- Recorded 2 receptions for a then-career-high 51 yards vs. Florida Atlantic (9/16)

### 2022: (CLEMSON – 12/1)

- Caught 10 passes for 128 yards in 290 offensive snaps over 12 games (one start) as a redshirt freshman
- Gained 44 yards on 3 receptions in the Orange Bowl vs. No. 6 Tennessee (12/30)
- Caught a 16-yard pass vs. No. 10 NC State (10/1)
- Despite tearing his ACL in spring practice, made his collegiate debut in Clemson's third game of the season, catching an 11-yard pass vs. Louisiana Tech (9/17)

### 2021: (CLEMSON – 3/0)

- Played in three games as a true freshman, preserving his redshirt season...Caught 4 passes for 56 yards

### — HIGH SCHOOL —

- National Top 125 player at Myrtle Beach (SC) HS
- Was named one of five finalists for Mr. Football in South Carolina and earned first-team All-State 4A by the South Carolina Coaches Association
- Had a strong senior year with 1,267 receiving yards on 65 catches with 16 TDs...Added 325 yards rushing on just 45 attempts (7.2 yards per rush) and 7 TDs, giving him 1,592 yards from scrimmage and 23 TDs...His best game came on senior night when he had 10 catches for 255 yards and 5 TDs vs. North Myrtle Beach
- Helped Myrtle Beach to 12-1 record as a senior (2021)
- Ranked as a 5-star player and No. 79 player in the nation by *PrepStar*, which also listed him as the No. 7 receiver in the nation and No. 6 player in South Carolina
- Rated No. 172 by *com*, 26th among WRs and fourth-best in South Carolina
- Selected to the Under Armour All-America Game in Orlando in January, played in North-South All-Star Game in Myrtle Beach and was a Shrine Bowl selection for South Carolina
- Ranked as No. 17 "Freak Athlete" in the country by *247Sports*
- Posted 46 receptions for 1,011 yards and 9 TDs as a junior (2020)
- Ran a 10.94 in the 100 meters at a track meet in 2020
- Myrtle Beach won a state championship in Randall's freshman year (2018)
