— KEY TRANSACTIONS —

- Aeneas Peebles was selected by the Ravens in the sixth round (210th overall) of the 2025 NFL Draft... Was the fourth of five Ravens draft picks in the round

— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Played in six games as a rookie in 2025, logging 3 tackles (2 solo), 1 QBH and 1 PD

— PERSONAL —

- Was a two-sport athlete (football and baseball) at Knightdale (NC) HS
- Transferred to Virginia Tech from Duke for his final year of college eligibility in 2024
- Nickname is “Fub,” because as a baby he was both fat and chubby
- His father, William, played on the defensive line at Appalachian State (1991-94), had an All-America senior season (23 TFL and 11.5 sacks) and has helped coach and develop his son
- His mother, Gia, was the first African American woman to play softball at Cal State Long Beach (1990-93) and helped guide the program to the College World Series in all four seasons... She went on to play professionally and served as the head softball coach at North Carolina Central in 1999
- His brother, Caleb Hawkins, played DE at Western Carolina (2012-15)
- His grandfather, Doug Wilkerson, was an All-American at North Carolina Central (1965-69) and was drafted in the first round (14th overall) of the 1970 NFL Draft by the Houston Oilers... Wilkerson enjoyed a 15-year NFL career as both a DE and G with the Oilers and San Diego Chargers (with San Diego, he earned three Pro Bowls and one All-Pro)... Wilkerson, who passed away in 2021, was inducted into the San Diego Chargers Hall of Fame and also served as a strength and conditioning coach for the Los Angeles Rams (1990-94) and as an executive for the St. Louis Rams (1995-96)

- Graduated from Duke with a degree in sociology in December 2023
- First name is pronounced: uh-NEE-iss, PEE-bulz**

2025: (BALTIMORE RAVENS — 6/0)

- Played in six games as a rookie, logging 3 tackles (2 solo), 1 QBH and 1 PD

— COLLEGE —

- Played five seasons of collegiate football at Virginia Tech (2024) and Duke (2020-23)... Appeared in 60 career games (15 starts), including starting all 12 games for the Hokies in 2024
- Recorded 118 tackles (39 solo), including 21 TFL, 11.5 sacks, 6 PD, 2 FFs and 1 FR throughout his collegiate career
- Prior to transferring to Virginia Tech, Peebles had a successful four-year career at Duke (2020-23), appearing in 48 games (three starts) and recording 87 tackles (28 solo), including 14.5 TFL, 8.5 sacks, 2 FFs, 1 FR and 1 PD for the Blue Devils
- Had a career-best 5 sacks and 9.5 TFL in his final season at Duke (2023)

— HIGH SCHOOL —

- Attended Knightdale (NC) HS, where he was a four-year letterwinner in football for the Knights... Posted 195 tackles, 27 sacks, 20 QBHs and blocked 2 FGAs in his final two seasons
- Named the 2019 Northern Athletic 4A Defensive Player of the Year
- Helped guide Knightdale to consecutive playoff appearances in 2018 and 2019
- Was a consensus three-star prospect by 247Sports, ESPN and Rivals
- Ranked as the nation’s No. 48 DT and the No. 15 overall recruit from North Carolina by Rivals
- Also played baseball (right field and third base) and twice lettered with the Knights
