- Saw action in 16 games (three starts) for the Colts in 2021...Caught a 2-yard TD pass in the third quarter vs. NYJ (11/4), becoming the first Colts OL to catch a TD pass since OL Anthony Castonzo vs. NE on 11/16/14
- Appeared in 13 games (one start) on offense and special teams for the Colts in his 2020 rookie season

- Played in 43 games (35 starts) across five seasons (2015-19) at Ball State, where he played both RT and TE...Voted a four-time All-MAC selection (2016-19)
- Started 12 games at RT as a senior, becoming one of two OL to start every game...Assisted in helping the offense rush for more than 200 yards in seven games...Awarded Ball State's John Magnabosco Award, which is given to the most outstanding player...Scored a 5-yard TD on a lateral at Central Michigan (11/16)
- Switched to OT in 2018 and started all 12 games...Blocked for an offense that rushed 51 times in a 24-23 victory at Central Michigan (10/13)...Helped the offense rush for a season-high 316 yards vs. Central Connecticut (8/30)
- Saw action in seven games (six starts) as a redshirt sophomore at TE, recording 6 receptions for 46 yards and 1 TD...Garnered the Ball State Ray Louthen Award, which is given to the most improved player...Suffered a season-ending injury vs. Central Michigan (10/21)
