— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- NFL's active leader in rushing yards (13,018) and rushing TDs (122)...His 122 rushing TDs rank fourth all time
- Among the 42 players in NFL history with at least 2,000 attempts, his 4.9 yards per carry rank third all time, trailing only HOFers Jim Brown (5.2 ypc) & Barry Sanders (5.0 ypc)
- Has produced at least 5 rushing TDs in each of his first 10-career seasons (2016-25), becoming the third player in NFL history to accomplish this feat
- Holds the most 200-yard rushing performances (seven) in NFL history...In each of Henry's seven 200-yard rushing performances, he's also tallied at least 2 rushing TDs...His seven games with at least 200 rushing yards and multiple rushing scores double the second-most amount of such performances by a player in NFL history, as Hall of Famers Jim Brown, Barry Sanders and LaDainian Tomlinson have each accomplished this single-game feat on three occasions
- His 14 games with at least 150 rushing yards and 2 rushing TDs are the most in NFL history
- Has 55 career regular season and four postseason (both are most among active players) 100-yard rushing performances
- His 87-yard rushing TD on the first play of the 9/29/24 primetime contest vs. Buf. marked the longest rush in franchise history
- Started all 17 games for the Ravens in 2025, notching 1,595 rushing yards and 16 TDs on 307 rushes (5.2 avg.)...Ranked second in the league in rushing yards behind James Cook (1,621) and second in rushing TDs behind Jonathan Taylor (18)...Finished the year ranking No. 10 on the NFL's all-time rushing yards list (13,018), No. 4 in career rushing TDs (122) and set the record for most career games with 150+ rushing yards and 2+TDs (14)...Led the team in first downs (83)...Pivotal for an offensive unit that ranked No. 1 in yards per rush (5.3), No. 2 in rushing ypg (156.6) and No. 3 in rushing TDs (23)...Baltimore's offense ranked seventh in yards per play (5.8)
- Started in all 17 games for Baltimore in 2024, producing 1,921 rushing yards and 16 TDs on 325 carries, producing the league's best ypc average (5.9) among qualified RBs, while adding 19 receptions for 193 yards and 2 TDs, en route to his fifth-career Pro Bowl nod...Finished the season tied for first in the NFL in rushing TDs (16), while ranking No. 2 in rushing yards (1,921) and tied for second in total scrimmage TDs (18)...Contributed to an offense that ranked No. 1 in the NFL in yards per game (424.9), yards per play (6.8 – third-best single-season mark in NFL history), yards per rush (5.8 – best mark in single-season NFL history) and red zone efficiency (74.2%) and No. 3 in points per game (30.5), while setting a franchise single-season record with 7,224 net yards

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- In 2024, reached the end zone in each of his first 11 games, becoming the fourth player since 1970 to accomplish this feat, joining Hall of Famers O.J. Simpson (first 14 in 1975), Jerry Rice (first 12 in 1987) and John Riggins (first 12 in 1983)...Surpassed RBs Ray Rice (15 in 2011) and Mark Ingram II (15 in 2019) for the most TDs scored (18) in Ravens single-season history, while also passing RB Jamal Lewis (14 in 2003) for the most ground scores (16) in Ravens single-season history
- Earned his fourth-career Pro Bowl nod in 2023 after starting all 17 games and ranking second in the NFL with 1,167 rushing yards on 280 carries (4.2 avg.), while adding 12 rushing TDs...Posted his first-career season without a fumble...Also posted 28 receptions for 214 yards and completed 2-of-3 passes for 14 yards and 2 TDs
- In 2023, became the eighth player in NFL history to reach 9,000 rushing yards and 80 rushing TDs before the age of 30, joining RBs Adrian Peterson, Barry Sanders, Emmitt Smith, Jim Brown, LaDainian Tomlinson, Eric Dickerson and Marshall Faulk
- In 2023, became the third player in NFL history to record 10-plus rushing TDs in six consecutive seasons, joining LaDainian Tomlinson (nine) and Adrian Peterson (seven)
- Earned his third-career Pro Bowl nod after posting the league's second-most rushing yards (1,538) and 13 TDs on 349 attempts (4.4 avg.) in 2022...Tied for third on the team with a career-high 33 receptions for a career-best 398 receiving yards, while completing both of his pass attempts for 4 yards and 1 TD...Named October's AFC Offensive Player of the Month after rushing for 563 yards and 5 TDs in four Titans' victories
- Started the first eight games of the 2021 season, leading the NFL with 937 rushing yards, 1,091 yards from scrimmage, 10 TDs and 56 total first downs, before being placed on Injured Reserve (foot) on 11/1/21...Also hauled in 18 receptions for 154 yards...Missed the final nine regular season games before returning for the Divisional Playoff vs. Cin. (1/22/22)
- In 2020, earned NFL Offensive Player of the Year, *Associated Press* first-team All-Pro and FedEx Ground Player of the Year honors, while being named to his second-career Pro Bowl after starting all 16 games and becoming just the eighth player in NFL history to eclipse 2,000 rushing yards in a season (2,027)...Totaled career highs in rushing yards (2,027) and rushing TDs (17) on 378 carries (5.4 avg.), while adding 19 catches for 114 yards...Became the first player since RB LaDainian Tomlinson (2006-07) to lead the NFL in rushing yards in consecutive seasons (2019-20)...Paced the NFL with 2,141 yards from scrimmage, which ranked second in franchise history behind RB Chris Johnson's 2,509 (2009)
- His 2,027 rushing yards in 2020 marked the fifth-highest total in NFL history, behind RBs Eric Dickerson's 2,105 (1984), Adrian Peterson's 2,097 (2012), Jamal Lewis' 2,066 (2003) and Barry Sanders' 2,053 (1997)...Became the first player since the 1970 NFL merger to lead the league in rushing yards (2,027), rushing attempts (378) and rushing TDs (17) in consecutive seasons
- In 2020, became the fifth player in NFL history to record three 200-yard rushing games in a season, joining RBs Earl Campbell (four in 1980), O.J. Simpson (1973), Tiki Barber (2005) and Jay Ajayi (2016)
- In 2020, became the first player in NFL history with five career games with at least 200 rushing yards and 2 rushing TDs...Also became the NFL's first player to rush for at least 175 and 2 TDs four times in a season
- Totaled 1,221 rushing yards in 2020 road games, marking the most in a single season by any NFL RB since 1948 (previous high of 1,087 was held by RB Eric Dickerson in 1984)...Dating back to 2019, posted a streak of nine consecutive road games with at least 100 rushing yards, passing RB Chris Johnson (eight games from 2009-10) for the second-longest streak in NFL history, behind only Barry Sanders' 10-game road streak (from 1996-97)
- In 2019, named the FedEx NFL Ground Player of the Year, an *Associated Press* second-team All-Pro and was selected to his first-career Pro Bowl after starting in all 15 appearances and leading the NFL with a then-career-best 1,540 rushing yards, while adding 16 rushing TDs, on 303 carries (5.1 avg.)...Also tallied 18 receptions for 206 yards and 2 TDs...Ranked second in the AFC and fourth in the NFL with a then-career-best 1,746 yards from scrimmage
- Started all three of the team's playoff games in 2019, finishing the postseason with 83 carries for a league-best 446 yards (5.4 avg.) and 2 TDs...Also hauled in 5 passes for 21 yards and threw a 3-yard TD pass...His 446 rushing yards in the postseason ranked second in franchise playoff history, only behind RB Eddie George's 449 rushing yards during the 1999 playoffs
- Played in all 16 games (12 starts) in 2018, tying for the AFC lead with 12 rushing TDs, while ranking second in the conference with 1,059 yards on 215 carries (4.9 avg.)...Also tallied 15 receptions for 99 yards and completed 2-of-3 passes for 14 yards
- Named AFC Offensive Player of the Week after rushing 17 times for a then-franchise-record 238 yards (14.0 avg.) and franchise-tying 4 TDs vs. Jax. (12/6/18)...Recorded the second 99-yard TD run in NFL history (RB Tony Dorsett)...His 238 rushing yards broke RB Chris Johnson's previous franchise record of 228 yards (11/1/09 vs. Jax.)...Became the seventh NFL player since the 1970 AFL-NFL merger with at least 4 rushing TDs and at least 200 rushing yards in a game, joining RBs Clinton Portis, Barry Sanders, Doug Martin, Jonas Gray, Mike Anderson and Corey Dillon...Also became the first player since the merger to run for at least 200 yards and 4 TDs on 20-or-fewer carries...Matched Johnson as the only players in NFL history with a rushing TD of at least 90 yards and a rushing TD of at least 50 yards in the same contest
- Saw action in all 16 games (two starts) in 2017, leading the team with 744 yards and 5 TDs on 176 carries (4.2 avg.), while adding 11 catches for 136 yards and 1 TD...Started his first two career playoff games, rushing for 184 yards and 1 TD on 35 carries, while adding 5 catches for 56 yards

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- Played in 15 games (two starts) as a rookie in 2016, ranking second on the team with 490 rushing yards and 5 TDs on 110 carries (4.5 avg.)...Also hauled in 13 receptions for 137 yards

- His late grandmother, Gladys Henry, helped raise him...Fulfilled his promise to her by graduating from Alabama in 2018...Has a portrait tattoo of her on his chest... Wore a purple suit to his Ravens introductory press conference in honor of his grandmother, whose favorite color was purple
- Wears the No. 22 as a tribute to his late friend and two-year Alabama teammate, Altee Tenpenny, who was killed in a car accident in 2015
- Founder of the Two All Foundation, which exists to level the playing field for today's youth by giving back to both the Nashville community and his hometown of Yulee, FL
- Is a minority owner of Nashville SC...Other current and former NFL players with ownership stakes in MLS teams include Russell Wilson (Seattle Sounders), Patrick Mahomes (Sporting KC) and Mark Ingram (D.C. United)
- His No. 2 jersey was retired at Yulee's spring football game in 2019
- Middle name is Lamar
- Has three daughters, Valentina, Celine & Monroe
- Before he even played in a high school game, county coaches instituted a policy that Yulee would have to remove Henry from the game if they had a 28-point lead

- Finished with a career-high 36 carries for 216 yards (third most in team history) and a franchise-record 4 TDs (matching a career-best) in Baltimore's 41-24 victory at GB (12/27)...Surpassed Tony Dorsett for 10th on the NFL's all-time rushing yards list and set the NFL record for most 200-yard games in a career (seven)...Surpassed Jim Brown (13) for the most career games in NFL history with 150+ rushing yards and 2+ TDs
- Notched a team-high 128 yards and 2 rushing TDs on 18 carries (7.1 avg.) NE (12/21)...Joined Hall of Fame RB LaDainian Tomlinson as the only players in NFL history to record 12+ rushing TDs in seven seasons...Became the sixth player all time with 40 career games with 1 rushing TD and over 100 yards, joining Pro Football Hall of Famers Emmitt Smith (56 games), Walter Payton (48), Barry Sanders (43), LaDainian Tomlinson (43) and Jim Brown (41)
- Registered 100 yards on 11 rushes in Baltimore's 24-0 victory at Cin. (12/15)
- Recorded 94 rushing yards on 25 attempts (3.8 avg.), and added 1 catch for 8 yards vs. Pit. (12/7)...He eclipsed 1,000 rushing yards on the season for the seventh time in his career, while becoming the fourth player all time with at least 1,000 rushing yards and 10 rushing TDs in seven career seasons, joining Pro Football Hall of Famers LaDainian Tomlinson (eight seasons), Emmitt Smith (seven) and Adrian Peterson (seven)
- Logged 60 yards and 1 TD on 10 rushes (6.0 avg.), and added 44 receiving yards on 1 catch vs. Cin. (11/27)...Surpassed Hall of Famer Jim Brown (12,312) for 11th on the NFL's all-time rushing yards list...Joined Hall of Famer LaDainian Tomlinson as the only players in NFL history with 10+ rushing TDs in 8+ consecutive seasons
- Notched 64 yards and 2 TDs on 21 rushes (3.0 avg.), while catching 2 passes for 24 yards (12.0 avg.) in Baltimore's 23-10 win vs. NYJ (11/23)...With his 64-yard performance, moved into 12th on the NFL's all-time rushing yards list (12,294 yards), surpassing Hall of Famers Marcus Allen (14th; 12,243 yards), Edgerrin James (13th; 12,246 yards) and Marshall Faulk (12th; 12,279 yards)...Became just the third player in NFL history to record 30 games with multiple rushing TDs in a career, joining Pro Football Hall of Famers Emmitt Smith and LaDainian Tomlinson

2025: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/17)

- Started all 17 games, notching 1,595 rushing yards and 16 TDs on 307 rushes (5.2 avg.)...Ranked second in the NFL in rushing yards behind James Cook (1,621) and second in rushing TDs behind Jonathan Taylor (18)...Finished the year at No. 10 on the NFL's all-time rushing yards list (13,018), No. 4 in career rushing TDs (122) and set the record for most career games with 150+ rushing yards and 2+TDs (14)...Led the team in first downs (83)...Pivotal for an offensive unit that ranked No. 1 in yards per rush (5.3), No. 2 in rushing ypg (156.6) and No. 3 in rushing TDs (23)...Baltimore's offense ranked seventh in yards per play (5.8)
- Tallied a game-high 126 yards on 20 rushes at Pit. (1/4/26)...Finished with the NFL's second-most rushing yards (1,595) on the season and tied his franchise record for TDs in a season (16)...Became the first player in NFL history to register back-to-back seasons with 1,500+ rush yards and 15+ rush TD at age 30 or older and the second player (Barry Sanders) to register five seasons with at least 1,500 yards
- Tallied 103 yards, including a season-long 59-yarder, and 1 TD on 18 rushes (5.7 avg.) in the 23-16 win at Cle. (11/16)...Recorded his fourth 100-yard rushing performance of the season and the 51st 100-yard game of his career
- Totaled 75 rushing yards on 20 carries (3.8 avg.) and 9 receiving yards on 3 catches in the 27-19 win at Min. (11/9)...Surpassed Pro Football Hall of Famers Thurman Thomas (12,074) and Franco Harris (12,120) for 15th on the NFL's all-time rushing yards list
- Rushed for 119 yards on 19 carries (6.3 avg.) at Mia. (10/30)...Became the eighth player in NFL history to reach at least 12,000 career rushing yards and 100 rushing TDs, and the 17th player to reach the 12,000-yard mark (12,052)

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- Finished with 71 yards and 2 TDs on 21 carries vs. Chi. (10/26)...His 2 rushing TDs were the 111th and 112th of his career, passing Pro Football Hall of Famer Walter Payton (110) for sole possession of fifth on the NFL's all-time list
- Finished with 122 rushing yards on 24 carries (5.1 avg.), adding 1 reception for 8 yards vs. LAR (10/12)...Registered his 49th career game with 100+ rushing yards, which tied RB Fred Taylor for the 10th most such games in NFL history
- Finished with 1 rushing TD and 33 yards on 15 carries vs. Hou. (10/5)...Notched a 1-yard TD in the third quarter, marking his 110th-career rushing TD, which tied Pro Football Hall of Famer Walter Payton for the fifth most in NFL history
- Totaled 169 rushing yards and 2 TDs on 18 carries (12.5 avg.), also adding 1 catch for 16 yards, at Buf. (9/7)...Surpassed HOFer Jim Brown (106) for sixth on the NFL's all-time rushing TD list (108)...Marked his 13th game with at least 150 rushing yards and 2 rushing TDs, tying Jim Brown (13) for the most such games by a player in NFL history...Henry recorded his 48th career 100-yard rushing game, which eclipsed HOFers Franco Harris & LaDainian Tomlinson (47 each) for the 11th most in NFL history...It marked Henry's 10th 100-yard game (reg. season) since joining the Ravens in 2024
- Totaled 186 rushing yards (franchise single-game playoff record) and 2 TDs on 26 attempts (7.2 avg.) in the 28-14 Wild Card win vs. Pit. (1/11/25)...Recorded his fourth-career playoff game with 150+ rushing yards, tying Pro Football Hall of Famer Terrell Davis for the most in NFL history...With 918 career postseason rushing yards, became the third player with 900+ rushing yards in the first eight playoff games of a career, joining Pro Football Hall of Famers Terrell Davis (1,140) and John Riggins (946)
- Produced 138 rushing yards and 2 TDs on 20 attempts (6.9 avg.), while adding 2 receptions for 23 yards in the 35-10 win vs. Cle. (1/4)...Passed RB Jamal Lewis (14 in 2003) for the most ground scores (16) in Ravens single-season history...Recorded his 22nd career performance with at least 100 rushing yards and 2 rushing TDs, surpassing Emmitt Smith (21) for the third-most such games in NFL history behind Hall of Famers Jim Brown (25) and LaDainian Tomlinson (25)
- Totaled 147 rushing yards and 1 TD on 27 attempts (5.4 avg.), while adding 2 receptions for 18 yards in the 31-2 win at Hou. (12/25)...Passed RBs Ray Rice (15 in 2011) and Mark Ingram II (15 in 2019) for the most TDs scored (16) in Ravens single-season history, while tying RB Jamal Lewis (2003) for the most ground scores (14) in Ravens single-season history...Moved into a tie with RB John Riggins for the seventh-most rushing TDs (104) in NFL history

2024: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/17, 2/2)

- Started in all 17 games, producing 1,921 rushing yards and 16 TDs on 325 carries, producing the league's best ypc average (5.9) among qualified RBs, while adding 19 receptions for 193 yards and 2 TDs, en route to his fifth-career Pro Bowl nod...Finished the season tied for first in the NFL in rushing TDs (16), while ranking No. 2 in rushing yards (1,921) and tied for second in total scrimmage TDs (18)...Surpassed RBs Ray Rice (15 in 2011) and Mark Ingram II (15 in 2019) for the most TDs scored (18) in Ravens single-season history, while also passing RB Jamal Lewis (14 in 2003) for the most ground scores (16) in Ravens single-season history...Reached the end zone in each of his first 11 games, becoming the fourth player since 1970 to accomplish this feat, joining Hall of Famers O.J. Simpson (first 14 in 1975), Jerry Rice (first 12 in 1987) and John Riggins (first 12 in 1983)...Contributed to an offense that ranked No. 1 in the NFL in yards per game (424.9), yards per play (6.8 – third-best single-season mark in NFL history), yards per rush (5.8 – best mark in single-season NFL history) and red zone efficiency (74.2%) and No. 3 in points per game (30.5), while setting a franchise single-season record with 7,224 net yards
- Produced 84 rushing yards on 16 attempts (5.3 avg.), while adding 1 TD on the ground in the Divisional Playoff at Buf. (1/19/25)...With his third rushing TD of the 2024 playoffs, marked the second-most rushing TDs by a Raven in a single postseason (Jamal Lewis, 2000 – 4)...Finishing the game with 1,002 career playoff rushing yards, became the first player in NFL history to record 1,000+ rushing yards in the first nine postseason games...Additionally, became the seventh player in NFL history to notch over 1,000 career rushing yards in postseason play
- Posted 82 rushing yards on 19 carries (4.3 avg.), while adding 3 receptions for 29 yards, vs. Phi. (12/1)...Recorded at least 65 rushing yards for the 12th-consecutive game, marking the longest streak of his career and the second-longest streak in Ravens franchise history (RB Jamal Lewis – 18)
- Totaled 24 carries for 140 rushing yards (5.8 avg.), including a season-high 9 first downs, in the MNF win at LAC (11/25)
- Posted 65 rushing yards and 1 rushing TD on 13 carries (5.0 avg.) at Pit. (11/17)...With his 15th total TD of the season, tied RBs Ray Rice (15 in 2011) and Mark Ingram II (15 in 2019) for the most TDs in Ravens single-season history...Became the fourth player since 1970 to reach the end zone in each of the first 11 games of a season, joining Hall of Famers O.J. Simpson (first 14 in 1975), Jerry Rice (first 12 in 1987) and John Riggins (first 12 in 1983)...Also became the third player in NFL history to record a rushing TD in 70 games within his first nine career seasons, joining Pro Football Hall of Famers LaDainian Tomlinson (87 games) and Emmitt Smith (83)

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- Totaled 23 carries for 106 yards (4.6 avg.) and 2 TDs, while adding 1 reception for 27 yards in the 41-10 win vs. Den. (11/3)...Became the fourth player in NFL history to post at least 10 rushing TDs in seven career seasons, joining RBs LaDainian Tomlinson (nine), Adrian Peterson (eight) and Emmitt Smith (eight)...With his 100th- and 101st-career rushing TDs, Henry surpassed Hall of Famers Barry Sanders (99) and Maro eclipsed 1,000 rushing yards on the season, his sixth time reaching the mark
- Recorded 11 rushes for 73 yards (6.6 avg.), including a game-long 39-yard gain, and 1 TD at Cle. (10/27)...With his eighth-straight game posting a TD, broke a tie with RB Willis McGahee (2007, Weeks 6-13) for the most consecutive games with a score in Ravens history...Tied Hall of Famer Barry Sanders (99) for the 10th-most rushing TDs in NFL history...Also became the first player in NFL history to reach the end zone in each of his first eight games with a team
- Totaled 169 rushing yards on 15 carries (11.3 avg.), while adding a 13-yard receiving TD in the 41-31 win at TB (10/21)...Recorded his second 80-plus yard rush of the season with a game-long 81-yard gain, becoming the league's first player since 2019 (KC's Damien Williams) to record multiple such rushes in a single season...Became the second player in NFL history (LAR's Eric Dickerson, 1983) to notch at least 800 rushing yards and 10 total TDs in their first seven games with a franchise...His 11.3 yards-per-carry average was the most by any player with 15+ rushing attempts in franchise history
- En route to AFC Offensive Player of the Week honors, rushed for 132 rushing yards and 2 TDs on 24 carries (5.5 avg.) in the 30-23 win vs. Was.
