2025: (USC – 11/9)

- Totalling career highs in receptions (49) and receiving yards (745), produced a 15.2 yards-per-catch average and 4 TDs, en route to earning third-team All-Big Ten honors
- Was part of a USC attack that ranked No. 8 in the nation in total offense (465.5 ypg) and No. 5 in passing (296.0 ypg)

- Tallied 6 catches for 108 receiving yards (18.0 avg.) at No. 6 Oregon (11/22)
- Registered 6 receptions for 111 receiving yards (18.5 avg.) and 1 TD at No. 13 Notre Dame (10/18)
- Posted 3 catches for a season-best 115 yards (38.3 avg.) in a victory at Purdue (9/13)
