- Started all 16 games in which he appeared in 2025, recording 105 tackles (59 solo), 1 sack, 7 TFL, 4 QBHs, 9 PD and 2 FFs, en route to his third-straight Pro Bowl nod and second-career AP first-team All Pro honors...Named the 2025 Ravens Media Good Guy and Team MVP, as voted on by local reporters...Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 3 in defensive total rush EPA (52.3), No. 5 in goal-to-go defense (64.7%) and No. 6 in red zone TD efficiency (50.8%)
- Started all 17 games for Baltimore in 2024, totaling a career-high 107 tackles (77 solo), 2 sacks, 4 TFL, 1 INT, 9 PD, 2 FFs and 1 FR, en route earning to his second-straight Pro Bowl nod...Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 1 against the run (80.1 ypg), No. 2 in sacks (54) and No. 5 (tied) in yards per play allowed (5.2)

- Started all 16 games in which he appeared, recording 105 tackles (59 solo), 1 sack, 7 TFL, 4 QBHs, 9 PD and 2 FFs, en route to his third-straight Pro Bowl nod and second-career AP first-team All Pro honors...Named the 2025 Ravens Media Good Guy and Team MVP, as voted on by local reporters...Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 3 in defensive total rush EPA (52.3), No. 5 in goal-to-go defense (64.7%) and No. 6 in red zone TD efficiency (50.8%)
- Notched a team-high 9 tackles (6 solo) and 1 PD at Pit. (1/4/26)
- Registered 5 solo tackles, including 1 TFL, and 1 PD vs. NE (12/21), helping limit the Patriots to 4-of-12 (33.3%) on third down

- Contributed 11 tackles (9 solo), including 1 TFL, and 1 QBH in the AFC Championship vs. KC (1/28/24), helping hold the Chiefs to 98 total yards and zero points in the second half
- Posted 5 tackles (3 solo), as well as career bests in INTs (2) and PD (3), in the 33-19 victory at SF (12/25)...Baltimore tied a single-game franchise record with 5 INTs (10/14/07 vs. STL), and Hamilton became the youngest Raven (22 years old) with a multi-INT performance

- Tallied a team-high 9 tackles (5 solo) and 1 FF (which he recovered) at Cin. in the Wild Card Playoff (1/15/23)...Became the first player in Ravens history to record at least 1 FF and 1 FR in a playoff debut, helping hold the Bengals to 234 total yards
- Tallied 6 tackles (5 solo) and 1 QBH to help force a third-down incomplection vs. Pit. (1/1/23)

- Posted 3 tackles (2 solo), including his first-career sack (-8 yards), in the 23-20 win vs. Cle. (10/23)...Became the first Ravens rookie defensive back since S Omar Brown (2012) to notch a sack
- Recorded his first-career FF (recovered by CB Marcus Peters) to halt a fourth-quarter drive in the 37-26 win at NE (9/25)...Baltimore's defense forced 4 turnovers (3 in the fourth quarter) for the first time since 2017 (12/17 at Cle.) and limited New England to 2-of-9 (22.2%) on third down
