— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Owns a Ravens-record 57 total TDs...Is one of two TEs (also Rob Gronkowski, Patriots) in NFL history standing as a franchise's all-time TDs record holder
- Ranks first all time in each of Baltimore's major receiving categories over the course of a Ravens career, including yards (5,952), TDs (56) and receptions (484)...Became the second tight end in NFL history (Travis Kelce) to hold the receiving "Triple Crown" as a franchise's all-time leader in yards, catches and TDs
- Owns the most 100-yard receiving games (10) and multi-TD receiving games (12) in Ravens history
- Owns the two longest regular season receptions by a TE in Ravens history, registering a 68-yard catch at LAC (12/22/18) and a record 74-yarder vs. Oak. (11/25/18)
- Appeared in all 17 games (11 starts) in 2025, notching 48 receptions for 422 yards and 5 TDs, while adding 10 rushes for 48 yards, including a 35-yard rushing TD...Finished the season as the franchise leader in career receptions (484), receiving yards (5,952) and receiving TDs (56), becoming just the second tight end in NFL history to hold that title for a club (Travis Kelce – KC)...Blocked for an offense that ranked No. 1 in the NFL in yards per rush (5.3), No. 2 in rushing yards per game (156.6) and No. 3 in rushing TDs (23)...Baltimore's offense also ranked seventh in overall yards per play (5.8) and 11th in points per game (24.9)

- Appeared in all 17 games (13 starts) for Baltimore in 2024, recording 55 receptions for 673 yards and a career-high 11 TDs...Finished the year first among all NFL TEs in TD receptions, while his 11 TDs was tied for fourth overall in the NFL...Tied WR Torrey Smith for the second-most receiving scores in Ravens single-season history behind WR Michael Jackson's 14 in 1996...Recorded a six-game streak with a receiving TD (Weeks 12-18), the longest such streak in franchise history...Contributed to an offense that ranked No. 1 in the NFL in yards per game (424.9), yards per play (6.8 – third-best single-season mark in NFL history) and red zone efficiency (74.2%) and No. 3 in points per game (30.5)
- Appeared in 10 games for the Ravens in 2023 (nine starts), posting 45 receptions for 544 yards and a team-high 6 TDs before being placed on Injured Reserve (11/25/23) with an ankle injury that sidelined him for the remainder of the regular season...He and Likely were the NFL's only pair of TEs with at least 5 TD grabs, while also becoming the first TE duo in Ravens history to accomplish the feat...Part of a Baltimore TEs group that led the NFL with 12 receiving TDs...Contributed to an offense that ranked fourth in scoring (28.4 ppg) and No. 6 in total yards (370.4 ypg)
- Started in all 15 games in which he appeared in 2022, producing team highs in all major receiving categories, including receptions (73 – tying for third most among NFL TEs), yards (847 – third most among NFL TEs) and TDs (5 – tying for seventh most among NFL TEs), en route to his third-career Pro Bowl...Also climbed to No. 3 in career receiving yards (4,313) and No. 2 in career receiving TDs (34) on the Ravens' all-time charts, while surpassing WR Mark Clayton for the most career 100-yard receiving games in franchise history (10)
- Played in all 17 games (nine starts) in 2021, totaling single-season franchise records in both receptions (107) and receiving yards (1,361)...Added 9 TD catches, en route to his second-career Pro Bowl nod and helping the Ravens produce the NFL's sixth-ranked offense (378.8 ypg)...Led NFL tight ends in all major receiving categories, including yards (1,361), receptions (107), TDs (9 – tied), first downs (75), 20-plus yard catches (20) and contested catches (18)
- On 12/26/21 at Cin., posted a team-high 8 catches for 125 yards and 1 TD...Recorded his third-straight game with at least 100 receiving yards and 1 TD grab, tying Jimmy Graham (2013) for the longest such streak by a TE in NFL history...It marked his fifth game reaching the century mark in 2021, setting a new Ravens' single-season record for most games with 100-plus receiving yards

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- On 12/19/21 vs. GB, tallied 10 catches for a game-high 136 receiving yards and 2 TDs on 13 targets...All 10 of his receptions moved the sticks, marking the most first-down grabs by all players in 2021 and in Ravens' single-game history...Became the 13th Raven and first TE in franchise history to produce 1,000 receiving yards in a season...Also became the second tight end ever with at least 10 catches, 100 receiving yards and a TD reception in consecutive games, joining Travis Kelce (Week 11 and Week 13, 2018)
- On 10/11/21 vs. Ind., set career highs in receptions (11) and receiving yards (147), also tying a career high with 2 TD catches and setting a personal best with 2 two-point conversions...His 147 receiving yards set a Ravens' single-game record by a TE, while his 11 receptions tied a previous single-game high for a Baltimore TE (Dennis Pitta in 2016)...Also became the first player since the 1970 merger to have 2 receiving TDs and 2 two-point conversions in a game
- In 2020, totaled 58 receptions for 701 yards and 7 receiving TDs for the NFL's seventh-best scoring offense (29.3 ppg) and fourth-best third-down offense (48.8%)...Helped block for the NFL's No. 1 rushing attack (191.9 ypg), which produced the third-most yards (3,071) ever in a 16-game NFL season
- Finished 2019 with team highs in receptions (64), receiving yards (852) and receiving TDs (10), helping Baltimore produce the NFL's No. 1 scoring offense (33.2 ppg)...The Ravens became the first team in NFL history to average at least 200 rushing (206.0) and 200 net passing yards (201.6) per game
- Helped set new single-season franchise records for total TDs (64), points (531), rushing yards (3,296) and total net yards (6,521) in 2019
- In 2019, produced the single-season franchise record for TD catches (10) by a TE...His 10 receiving TDs tied (LAR's Cooper Kupp) for No. 2 in the NFL and ranked No. 1 among all TEs
- Is one of three Ravens ever to post at least 10 receiving TDs in a season (Torrey Smith, 11 in 2014; Michael Jackson, 14 in 1996), doing so in 2019
- On 12/1/19 vs. SF, scored Baltimore's 48th total TD of the season, setting a new franchise record (12/1/19)
- Became the first Ravens TE to post back-to-back 100-yard receiving games in the victory vs. Ari. (9/15/19)
- Posted then-career highs in receiving yards (108) and receptions (8) to help the Ravens produce franchise records in yards (643) and points (59) in the season-opening 59-10 victory at Mia. (9/8/19)
- In 2018, became the Ravens' record holder for most receptions (34) and receiving yards (552) in a season by a rookie TE, passing Maxx Williams (32 for 268 in 2015)
- Andrews' 552 receiving yards in 2018 ranked No. 1 among all NFL rookie TEs...His 34 receptions stood third
- Father, Paul, and brother, Jack, are urologists, while his sister, Annie, is a dentist...Mother, Martha, and another brother, Charlie, both work in real estate
- Mark proposed to his fiancée, Elena Yates, during the same week (in 2025) he signed a three-year contract extension

2025: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/11)

- Appeared in all 17 games (11 starts), notching 48 receptions for 422 yards and 5 TDs, while adding 10 rushes for 48 yards, including a 35-yard rushing TD...Finished the season as the franchise leader in career receptions (484), receiving yards (5,952) and receiving TDs (56), becoming just the second tight end in NFL history to hold that title for a club (Travis Kelce – KC)...Blocked for an offense that ranked No. 1 in the NFL in yards per rush (5.3), No. 2 in rushing yards per game (156.6) and No. 3 in rushing TDs (23)...Baltimore's offense also ranked seventh in overall yards per play (5.8) and 11th in points per game (24.9)
- Totaled 47 yards on 4 catches (11.8 avg.) vs. Cin. (11/27)...With an 8-yard reception in the fourth quarter, broke the franchise's all-time receptions record previously held by Derrick Mason (471)...Became the second TE in NFL history (Travis Kelce) to hold the receiving "Triple Crown" as a franchise's all-time leader in yards, catches and TDs
- Finished with 32 yards on 3 receptions (10.7 avg.) and posted a 35-yard rushing TD in the 23-16 win at Cle. (11/16)...With an 11-yard catch in the first quarter, became the franchise career leader in receiving yards, surpassing Derrick Mason (5,777)...Also became the fifth TE in NFL history to lead a franchise in career receiving yards, joining Jason Witten (12,977 – Cowboys), Travis Kelce (12,782 – Chiefs), Antonio Gates (11,841 – Chargers) and Ozzie Newsome (7,980 – Browns)...Scored a go-ahead 35-yard rushing TD on fourth-and-1 in the fourth quarter, marking his first-career rushing TD (also first by a TE in Ravens history) and the longest rushing score by a traditional NFL TE since at least 2000
- Notched 2 receiving TDs on 2 receptions for 22 yards at Mia. (10/30)...Recorded the 54th and 55th receiving TDs of his career, passing Pro Football Hall of Famer Tony Gonzalez (54) for the fourth-most TDs by a tight end in the first eight seasons of a career
- Notched a team-high 91 receiving yards and 2 TDs on 6 receptions (15.2 avg.) vs. Det. (9/22)...Marked his 11th-career game with multiple TDs, the most such games in franchise history and the NFL's third most since 2019

- Was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes and wears an insulin pump, except when he plays football...Passionate spokesperson for those with diabetes and educating youth about its effects and ways to overcome the ailment

2024: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/13, 2/2)

- Appeared in all 17 games (13 starts), recording 55 receptions for 673 yards and a career-high 11 TDs...Finished the year first among all NFL TEs in TD receptions, while his 11 TDs was tied for fourth overall in the NFL...Tied WR Torrey Smith for the second-most receiving scores in Ravens single-season history behind WR Michael Jackson's 14 in 1996...Became the first player in Ravens history with multiple seasons (also 2019) notching 10+ receiving scores...Recorded a six-game streak with a receiving TD (Weeks 12-18), the longest such streak in franchise history... Contributed to an offense that ranked No. 1 in the NFL in yards per game (424.9), yards per play (6.8 – third-best single-season mark in NFL history) and red zone efficiency (74.2%) and No. 3 in points per game (30.5), while setting franchise single-season records with 7,224 net yards and 65 TDs
- Tallied a team-high 5 receptions for 61 yards in the Divisional Playoff at Buf. (1/19/25)
- Registered 4 catches for 54 yards and 1 TD in the 35-10 win vs. Cle. (1/4)...With the 12-yard TD, set a new career high with 11 receiving TDs on the season, tying WR Torrey Smith for the second-most receiving scores in Ravens single-season history behind WR Michael Jackson's 14 in 1996...Tallied a receiving TD for the sixth-consecutive game, setting a Ravens franchise record...Finishing the game with 5,530 career receiving yards, surpassed TE Todd Heap (5,492) for the second-most receiving yards in Ravens history
- Recorded 2 catches for a team-high 68 yards, including a 67-yarder (the third-longest reception of his career) and 1 TD in the 31-2 win at Hou. (12/25)...With the 1-yard TD, became the first player in Ravens history with multiple seasons (also 2019) notching 10+ receiving scores...Tallied a receiving TD for the fifth-consecutive game, tying WR Michael Jackson for the longest-such streak in franchise history
- Posted 4 receptions for 37 yards and 1 TD in the 34-17 win vs. Pit. (12/21)...With the scoring grab, Andrews tallied a receiving TD for the fourth-consecutive contest, marking the longest streak by a TE in Ravens franchise history
- Posted 2 receptions for 24 yards and 1 TD in the 35-14 win at NYG (12/15)...With the scoring grab, Andrews (48 TDs) surpassed RB Jamal Lewis (47) for sole possession of the top spot on the Ravens' all-time total TDs list...Surpassed 500 receiving yards on the season in the contest, breaking a tie with TE Todd Heap & WR Derrick Mason for the most seasons (seven) tallying at least 500 receiving yards in a Ravens career...Also became the fifth TE in NFL history with at least 500 receiving yards in each of his first seven seasons, joining Rob Gronkowski, George Kittle, Keith Jackson and Pro Football Hall of Famer Ozzie Newsome
- Recorded a game-high 6 receptions for 67 receiving yards, including a 14-yard TD in the first quarter, vs. Phi. (12/1)...With the scoring grab, Andrews tied RB Jamal Lewis' franchise record of 47 total TDs in a Ravens career...Also tied WR Derrick Mason for the most games (54) with 50-plus receiving yards in Ravens history

- Tallied 5 catches for 44 yards, including a 6-yard TD grab in the back of the end zone that gave Baltimore a fourth-quarter 23-16 lead, in the MNF win at LAC (11/25)...Pushed forward for a key fourth-and-1 conversion from the team's own 16-yard line, marking the league's deepest successful fourth-down try since the 2012 Rams (11/11/12 at SF)
- Registered 6 catches for 68 yards and 1 TD in the 35-34 win vs. Cin. (11/7)...Marked his sixth season with at least 5 receiving TDs, surpassing TE Todd Heap for the most seasons with at least 5 receiving TDs in a Ravens career
- Tallied 5 receptions for 36 yards, including a 7-yard TD at Cle. (10/27)...Added a receiving TD for the third-consecutive game, tying a career-high scoring streak (2021, Weeks 14-16)...Surpassed RB Ray Rice (43) for the second-most total TDs (44) in franchise history...Became the third player (also TE Todd Heap & WR Derrick Mason) in franchise history to reach 400 career receptions
- Posted 4 catches for 41 yards and 2 TDs in the 41-31 win at TB (10/21)...Surpassed TE Todd Heap for the most TD receptions (43) by any player in franchise history...Also became the Ravens' all-time leader in games (10) with multiple TD receptions
- Registered 3 catches for 66 yards and 1 TD in the 30-23 win vs. Was. (10/13)...Recorded his 41st-career receiving TD, tying TE Todd Heap for the most receiving TDs in Ravens franchise history...Also surpassed 5,000 career receiving yards in the contest, becoming the third – and fastest – player to reach the mark in a Ravens career
- Tallied 4 receptions for a season-high 55 yards in the 41-38 OT win at Cin. (10/6)...Recorded his 51st-career game with 50+ receiving yards, surpassing TE Todd Heap (50) for the most such performances by a Ravens TE

2023: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 10/9, 1/0, INJURED RESERVE)

- Appeared in 10 games (nine starts), posting 45 receptions for 544 yards and a team-high 6 TDs before being placed on Injured Reserve (11/25) with an ankle injury that sidelined him for the remainder of the regular season...He and Likely were the NFL's only single-team pair of TEs with at least 5 TD grabs, while also becoming the first TE duo in Ravens history to accomplish the feat...Was part of a Baltimore TEs group that led the NFL with 12 receiving TDs...Contributed to an offense that ranked fourth in scoring (28.4 ppg) and No. 6 in total yards (370.4 ypg)
- Returned from injury for the AFC Championship vs. KC (1/28/24)...Posted 2 receptions for 15 yards in his first game action since Week 11
- Registered 4 receptions for 40 yards and 1 TD in the 31-24 win at Ari. (10/29)...Became the fourth TE (also Antonio Gates, Jimmy Graham and Rob Gronkowski) since the 1970 merger to reach 40 receiving TDs in the first six years of a career
- Registered 4 receptions for 63 yards and 2 red zone TDs in the 38-6 win vs. Det. (10/22)...Recorded his ninth multi-TD receiving game, tying Todd Heap for the most such performances by any player in Ravens history

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- Tallied 4 receptions for a team-high 69 yards – including a season-long 38 yarder – in the 24-16 victory at Ten. (10/15 in London)
- Posted team highs in receptions (5), receiving yards (80) and receiving TDs (2) in the 28-3 win at Cle. (10/1)...With both scores occurring on third down from inside the 20-yard line, surpassed TE Todd Heap (28) for the most red zone TD grabs in franchise history
- Made his season debut, tallying 5 receptions for 45 yards and 1 TD in the 27-24 victory at Cin. (9/17)...His 3-yard TD grab capped a 4-play scoring drive that was kickstarted by a WR Zay Flowers 52-yard reception

2022: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 15/15, 1/1)

- Started in all 15 games in which he appeared, producing team highs in all major receiving categories, including receptions (73 – tying for third most among NFL TEs), yards (847 – third most among NFL TEs) and TDs (5 – tying for seventh most among NFL TEs), en route to his third-career Pro Bowl...Also climbed to No. 3 in career receiving yards (4,313) and No. 2 in career receiving TDs (34) on the Ravens' all-time charts, while surpassing WR Mark Clayton for the most career 100-yard receiving games in franchise history (10)
- Recorded team and single-game postseason career highs in receptions (5) and receiving yards (73), with 3 of his catches yielding first downs, in the Wild Card Playoff at Cin. (1/15/23)
- Led the team with 9 catches and 100 yards vs. Pit. (1/1/23), marking his third 100-yard outing of the season and the 10th of his career...Surpassed WR Mark Clayton for the most 100-yard receiving games (10) in Ravens history
- Posted 4 receptions for a team-high 53 yards in the 10-9 win vs. Den. (12/4)...Also drew a 17-yard pass interference penalty that brought Baltimore to Denver's 37-yard line and registered fourth-down 1-yard conversion on a direct snap during its game-winning 16-play, 91-yard TD drive
- Posted 6 receptions for 63 yards in the 13-3 win vs. Car. (11/20)...Eclipsed 4,000 career receiving yards in the contest, becoming the third Raven (TE Todd Heap and WR Derrick Mason) to reach that mark, while joining a group of four other TEs since the 1970 AFL-NFL merger (Antonio Gates, Jimmy Graham, Rob Gronkowski & Kellen Winslow Sr.) to tally 4,000 receiving yards and 30 TD receptions within the first five years of a career
- Posted a game-high 7 catches for 106 yards and 1 TD at NYG (10/16)...Tied WR Mark Clayton for the most 100-yard receiving games (nine) in Ravens history and surpassed WR Derrick Mason for the most games (24) with at least 50 receiving yards and 1 TD in franchise history
- Recorded a team-high 8 catches for 89 yards and 1 TD in the 19-17 victory vs. Cin. (10/9)...Also notched his 23rd-career game with at least 50 receiving yards and 1 TD, tying WR Derrick Mason for the most games reaching those marks in Ravens history

- Recorded a team-high 89 receiving yards and 2 TDs on 8 receptions, scoring both TDs in the red zone, in the 37-26 win at NE (9/25)...It marked his 12th-straight game with 50 receiving yards...In his seventh-career multi-TD performance, the second most by a Raven (Todd Heap – 9), Andrews also surpassed WR Torrey Smith for the second-most TD receptions (31) in team history (Heap – 41)
- Posted a team-high 9 receptions for 104 yards and 1 TD vs. Mia. (9/18), marking his eighth-career 100-yard performance...Notched his 30th-career TD reception on a 1-yard grab, joining Mike Ditka (32), Antonio Gates (43), Tony Gonzalez (30), Jimmy Graham (51), Rob Gronkowski (54) and Kellen Winslow Sr. (35) as one of seven TEs in NFL history to reach that figure in the first five seasons of a career...Also moved into third place in career receiving yards (3,559) and receiving TDs (30) on Baltimore's all-time charts
- Recorded a team-high 5 receptions for 52 yards in the 24-9 victory at NYJ (9/11), extending his streak of 50-yard games to 10...Became just the sixth NFL TE since the 1970 merger to produce at least 50 receiving yards in 10 straight games

2021: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/9)

- Played in all 17 games (nine starts), totaling single-season franchise records in both receptions (107) and receiving yards (1,361)...Added 9 TD catches, en route to his second-career Pro Bowl nod and helping the Ravens produce the NFL's sixth-ranked offense (378.8 ypg)...Led NFL tight ends in all major receiving categories, including yards (1,361), receptions (107), TDs (9 – tied), first downs (75), 20-plus yard catches (20) and contested catches (18)
- Posted a team-high 8 receptions for 85 yards in the season finale vs. Pit. (1/9/22)...Surpassed Derrick Mason's franchise single-season receptions record (103 in 2007), finishing with 107...Notched at least 85 receiving yards for the fifth-consecutive game, marking the longest streak by a tight end in NFL history
- Recorded 6 catches for a team-high 89 yards vs. LAR (1/2/22), setting a new Ravens' single-season record for receiving yards (1,276) and surpassing WR Michael Jackson's previous franchise mark of 1,201 in 1996
- Posted a team-high 8 catches for 125 yards and 1 TD at Cin. (12/26)...Recorded his third-straight game with at least 100 receiving yards and 1 TD grab, tying Jimmy Graham (2013) for the longest such streak by a TE in NFL history...It marked his fifth game reaching the century mark in 2021, setting a new Ravens' single-season record for most games with 100-plus receiving yards
- Tallied 10 catches for a game-high 136 receiving yards and 2 TDs on 13 targets vs. GB (12/19)...All 10 of his receptions moved the sticks, marking the most first-down grabs by a player this season and in Ravens single-game history...Became the 13th Raven and first TE in franchise history to produce 1,000 receiving yards in a season...Also became the second tight end ever with at least 10 catches, 100 receiving yards and a TD reception in consecutive games, joining Travis Kelce (Week 11 and Week 13, 2018)

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- Posted a career-high-tying 11 receptions for 115 yards and 1 TD at Cle. (12/12), marking his third 100-yard outing of the season and the fifth of his career... Became the Ravens' single-season record holder for most receiving yards (926) by a TE, surpassing Todd Heap's previous record (855 in 2005)
- Recorded 4 receptions for 50 yards at Pit. (12/5)... With 3 first-down receptions, he posted his 45th chain-moving grab of the season, setting a new record by a Ravens' TE
- Posted 4 receptions for 65 yards and 1 TD in the 16-10 win vs. Cle. (11/28)... Eclipsed 50 receptions, 700 receiving yards and 5 receiving TDs for the third-consecutive season, also becoming the fourth Raven in franchise history to reach 25 career TD catches
- Registered a team-high 8 catches for 73 yards, with 5 first-down grabs, in the 16-13 win at Chi. (11/21)... Eclipsed 50 receptions for the third-consecutive season and surpassed WR Travis Taylor (2,758) for the seventh-most receiving yards in franchise history (2,801)
- Recorded 6 catches for 63 yards and 1 TD at Mia. (11/11)... Ended the contest with 204 career receptions, becoming the second-fastest Raven (54 games) to eclipse the 200 mark (Ray Rice – 51 games)
- Tallied a game-high 68 receiving yards and 1 TD on 5 catches in the 34-6 win vs. LAC (10/17)... Reeled in a team-long 21-yard reception to set up RB Le'Veon Bell's 2-yard TD run
- Set career highs in receptions (11) and receiving yards (147), also tying a career high with 2 TD catches and setting a personal best with 2 two-point conversion catches, in the 31-25 win vs. Ind. (10/11)... His 147 receiving yards set a Ravens' single-game record by a TE, while his 11 receptions tied a previous single-game high for a Baltimore TE (Dennis Pitta in 2016)... Became the first NFL player since the 1970 merger to have 2 receiving TDs and 2 two-point conversions in a game... Also joined WR Marquise Brown to form the first tandem in Ravens history with 100 receiving yards and 2 TD grabs, respectively, in the same game
- Recorded 5 receptions for 67 yards in the 23-7 win at Den. (10/3)... All 5 of his catches moved the chains
- Posted 5 receptions for a game-high 106 receiving yards, including a 41-yard grab, in the 19-17 win at Det. (9/26)... In the contest, Andrews collected his 169th-career catch, surpassing TE Todd Heap (168) for the most receptions by a TE in his first four seasons as a Raven
