— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Started all 17 games for the Ravens in 2024, totaling 43 tackles (21 solo), 6.5 sacks, 11 TFL, 1 PD and 1 FF, en route to earning his second-straight Pro Bowl nod... Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 1 against the run (80.1 ypg) and No. 2 in both sacks (54) and fourth-down efficiency (42.9%)
- Started all 17 games for Baltimore in 2023, contributing career bests in tackles (56), sacks (13), TFL (12), QBHs (33) and FF (2), en route to earning his first Pro Bowl nod and second-team All-Pro honors... Led all NFL DTs in sacks and tied an NFL single-season record for most consecutive games (11) with at least a half-sack... Helped the Ravens' defense become the first unit in NFL history to lead the league in scoring (16.5), sacks (60) and takeaways (31)
- Started 16 of 17 games in 2022, recording career-highs in tackles (42), TFL (8), sacks (5.5) QBHs (9) and PD (3)... Helped Baltimore's defense rank in the Top 5 in four categories: No. 3 in points allowed per game (18.5), No. 3 in defensive red zone TD% (46.4), No. 3 in rushing yards per game (92.1) and No. 4 in third-down efficiency (34.9%)
- Notched his first-career sack in the 27-13 win vs. NYG (12/27/20)
- Made his NFL debut and tallied 1 QBH in the 27-3 win vs. Cin. (10/11/20)

— PERSONAL —

- Officially changed his name from Justin to Nnamdi, his Nigerian-given name, prior to the start of the 2024 season..."Just learning from the older vets and stuff, I keep finding ways to get better every single year...I just started to just keep everything real in terms of my life," he said..."After I signed my contract, I just need to keep doing that...I just felt like when I keep it real, the better player I am, the better man I am...I just was like, you know, I'm going to go with my real name...So, Nnamdi is my real name"
- Nnamdi is the name both of his parents have always used to refer to him, but starting in elementary school, his peers referred to him by his American name, Justin
- The name Nnamdi means "my father's son" or "my father's legacy" and Madubuike means "my family is my strength"
- In high school, participated in the PALS (Peer Assistance & Leadership) program that mentors children in the community
- His parents, Maureen and Festus Madubuike, are immigrants from Nigeria... Festus runs a home healthcare company called "Lucent Home Health"
- Modeled his game after Hall of Fame DE and fellow Texas native, John Randle, when he first started playing football
- Weighed 10 pounds at birth
- **Name is pronounced: NAHM-dee, mad-uh-BEE-kay**

2025: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 2/2)

- Started the first two games of the season, recording 7 tackles (5 solo), 2 sacks and 3 QBHs, before being placed on Injured Reserve (neck)
- Posted 2 QBHs, including a 7-yard sack on QB Joe Flacco, in the 41-17 victory vs. Cle. (9/14), marking the 30th sack of his career
- Recorded 6 tackles (4 solo), including 1 sack, 1 QBH and 1 TFL (-5 yards), in the season opener at Buf. (9/7)

2024: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/17, 2/2)

- Started all 17 games, totaling 43 tackles (21 solo), 6.5 sacks, 11 TFL, 1 PD and 1 FF, en route to earning his second-straight Pro Bowl nod... Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 1 against the run (80.1 ypg), No. 2 in sacks (54) and No. 5 (tied) in yards per play allowed (5.2)
- Tallied a playoff career-best 7 tackles (2 solo), including a half-sack (OLB Kyle Van Noy), in the Divisional Playoff at Buf. (1/19/25), becoming the first Raven since Terrell Suggs (four games – 2009-10) to record at least a half-sack in three consecutive playoff games

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- Registered 4 tackles (3 solo), including 2 sacks (-8 yards), and 1 PD in the 28-14 Wild Card win vs. Pit. (1/11/25), helping limit the Steelers to just 29 rushing yards – the third fewest ever allowed by the Ravens in a postseason game... Became the first player since Elvis Dumervil (2014 WC vs. Pit.) to record multiple sacks in a postseason game
- Registered a third-quarter sack (-4 yards) in the 31-2 win at Hou. (12/25)... Baltimore's defense shut out the Texans, limiting them to just 211 total yards (58 rushing & 153 passing) and 4-of-15 (26.7%) on third down
- Posted 7 tackles (4 solo), including 2 TFL and a half-sack (OLB Kyle Van Noy), in the 34-17 win vs. Pit. (12/21), helping the defense limit the Steelers 4-of-10 (40%) on third down
- Registered 5 tackles (3 solo), including a career-high 3 sacks (-7 yards), and 1 FF in the 35-34 win vs. Cin. (11/7)... Became the first Raven since S Kyle Hamilton (9/24/23 vs. Ind.) to post at least 3 sacks in a game
- Notched 2 tackles and a half-sack (NT Michael Pierce) in the 30-23 victory vs. Was. (10/13), contributing to a unit that limited the Commanders to 52 rushing yards and 4-of-12 (33.3%) on third down
- Recorded 4 tackles (2 solo) and 1 sack (-7 yards) in the 41-38 OT win at Cin. (10/6), contributing to a unit that limited Cincinnati to 71 rushing yards
- Collected 3 solo tackles, including 2 TFL, vs. LV (9/15)... Helped limit the Raiders to just 27 rushing yards, tied for the 12th fewest in Ravens single-game history
- Registered 2 total tackles, including a half-sack, at KC (9/5)... Baltimore's defense limited the Chiefs to just 72 yards rushing and 1-of-3 (33%) in the red zone
- Recorded a career-high (tied) and season-high 7 tackles (5 solo), including 1 sack (-8 yards), and 5 QBHs in the 37-31 OT victory vs. LAR (12/10)... Became the first Ravens defensive lineman since NT Kelly Gregg (12/16/07 at Mia.) to post at least 7 tackles and 1 sack in a single half of a game
- Recorded a half-sack (-3.5 yards) and 3 QBHs in the 20-10 win at LAC (11/26), becoming the first Raven to record double-digit sacks (10) in season since OLB Terrell Suggs (11) in 2017
- Recorded 3 total tackles, including 1 sack (-2 yards), in the 34-20 win vs. Cin. (11/16), helping the defense register 5 sacks and hold the Bengals to 2-of-11 (18.2%) on third down
- Collected 3 tackles (1 solo), including 1 sack (-5 yards), and 3 QBHs vs. Cle. (11/12)... His five consecutive games with a full sack tied (several players) for the longest such streak in franchise history... The contest also marked his seventh-straight game with at least a half-sack, further extending his franchise record
- Contributed 4 total tackles, including 1 sack (-7 yards), and 2 TFL in the 37-3 win vs. Sea. (11/5)... Set a new Ravens record for the longest streak of consecutive games (six) with at least a half-sack, as Baltimore's defense permitted season-lows in total yards (151), rushing yards (28), first downs (six) and third-down conversions (1-of-12, 8.3%)
- Posted 3 solo tackles, including 1 sack (-5 yards), and a team-high 3 QBHs in the 31-24 victory at Ari. (10/29)... Set a new career high with 6.5 sacks on the season, while also matching the longest streak of consecutive games with at least a half-sack (five, by several players) in Ravens history
- Notched 3 total tackles and 1 strip-sack (-4 yards), which was his first-career FF, in the 38-6 win vs. Det. (10/22)... Baltimore's 5 sacks tied a franchise record (set in 2006) of three straight home games reaching that mark

2023: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/17, 2/2)

- Started all 17 games, contributing career bests in tackles (56), sacks (13), TFL (12), QBHs (33) and FFs (2), en route to earning his first Pro Bowl nod and second-team All-Pro honors... Led all NFL DTs in sacks and tied an NFL single-season record for most consecutive games (11) with at least a half-sack... Helped the Ravens' defense become the first unit in NFL history to lead the league in scoring (16.5), sacks (60) and takeaways (31)
- Collected 6 tackles (2 solo), including a half-sack (-1 yard), in the AFC Championship vs. KC (1/28/24), helping hold the Chiefs to 98 total yards and zero points in the second half
- Recorded 3 tackles (2 solo), including 1 TFL, and 2 QBHs for a Ravens' defense that allowed just 3 points and 213 total yards (38 rushing & 175 passing) in the Divisional Playoff victory vs. Hou. (1/20/24)
- Posted 5 tackles (1 solo), including 1 sack (-6 yards), in the 56-19 victory vs. Mia. (12/31)... Baltimore's defense posted 3 takeaways, 3 sacks and limited the Dolphins' No. 1 scoring offense to just 19 points
- Posted a strip-sack (-6 yards) and team-best 4 QBHs in the 23-7 win at Jax. (12/17)... His sack tied DE Trey Hendrickson (2021), DT Chris Jones (2018), DE Jared Allen (2010-11) and DE Shaun Ellis (2002-03) for the most consecutive games (11) with at least a half-sack in NFL history
- Totaled 5 tackles (4 solo), and a career- and team-high (tied Jadeveon Clowney) 4 QBHs, including 2 sacks (-15 yards), in the 24-16 win at Ten. (10/15 in London)... Baltimore's defense totaled a season-high 6 sacks while permitting a season-low 1-of-9 (11.1%) on third down
- Registered 5 tackles (3 solo) and a half-sack (ILB Patrick Queen) at Pit. (10/8)
- Registered 2 tackles (1 solo), which included 1 sack (-13 yards) of QB Dorian Thompson-Robinson, in the 28-3 win at Cle. (10/1)... The defense permitted just 166 total yards (93 rushing and 73 passing), marking its fewest since 12/2/18 at Atl. (131 yards)... Baltimore stacked its 25th-straight game with a sack, setting a new franchise record
- Recorded an 11-yard sack – his third sack in the last four games (dating back to 12/24/22 vs. Atl.) – 2 tackles, 1 QBH and 1 TFL in the 25-9 season-opening victory vs. Hou. (9/10)... Contributed to a defense that permitted just 1 rushing first down, while limiting Houston to 7-of-18 (38.9%) on third down and 1-of-4 (25%) on fourth down

2022: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/16, 1/1)

- Started 16 of 17 games, recording then-career highs in tackles (42), TFL (8), sacks (5.5) QBHs (9) and PD (3)...Helped Baltimore's defense rank in the Top 5 in four categories: No. 3 in points allowed per game (18.5), No. 3 in defensive red zone TD% (46.4), No. 3 in rushing yards per game (92.1) and No. 4 in third-down efficiency (34.9%)
- Recorded a career-high 7 tackles (5 solo), 1 sack and 1 TFL in the 17-9 win vs. Atl. (12/24)...Baltimore's defense held Atlanta to 5-of-14 (35.7%) on third down and 1-of-4 (25%) on fourth down, while allowing zero touchdowns on four red zone trips
- Posted 1 sack (-4 yards) in the 27-22 win at TB (10/27)... Baltimore's defense limited Tampa Bay to 4-of-13 (30.8%) on third down

- Notched his first-career sack in the 27-13 win vs. NYG (12/27)...Also helped limit the Giants to 1-of-10 (10%) on third down, matching the Ravens' eighth-best defensive third-down percentage in single-game franchise history
- Totaled 3 tackles (2 solo) and 1 TFL in a standout performance for Baltimore's run defense in the 40-14 win vs. Jax. (12/20)...Helped limit Jacksonville's rushing attack to 62 yards on 22 carries (2.8 avg)
- Notched a then-career-high 5 tackles (3 solo) in the 24-10 win at Ind. (11/8)...Baltimore's defense pitched a second-half shutout to help secure the team's 10th-consecutive road victory
