— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Appeared in 13 games (12 starts) with the Ravens in 2025, totaling 19 receptions for 224 yards and 2 receiving TDs... Contributed to an offense that ranked seventh in yards per play (5.8) and 11th in points per game (24.9)
- Played in all 17 games (14 starts) for Baltimore in 2024, tallying 45 receptions to go along with career highs in receiving yards (756) and receiving TDs (9)... Recorded three receiving TDs of at least 40 yards, tied for the most such scores in a season by a Raven since at least 2000... Teamed with TE Mark Andrews (11 receiving TDs) to form the first Ravens duo since WRs Derrick Alexander and Michael Jackson in 1996 to each record 9 or more receiving TDs in the same season... Contributed to an offense that ranked No. 1 in the NFL in yards per game (424.9), yards per play (6.8 – third-best single-season mark in NFL history) and red zone efficiency (74.2%) and No. 3 in points per game (30.5), while setting a franchise single-season record with 7,224 net yards
- Saw action in 16 games (12 starts) with the Ravens in 2023, registering 32 catches for 367 yards and 1 TD... Was one of six Ravens to eclipse 300 receiving yards, as Baltimore tied (Cincinnati, Detroit, Green Bay and Washington) for the NFL's most players reaching that mark... Contributed to an offense that ranked fourth in scoring (28.4 ppg) and No. 6 in total yards (370.4 ypg)
- Saw action in 12 games (four starts) during his 2021 rookie campaign after missing the first five weeks of the season with a groin injury... Totaled 46 receptions for 515 yards and 1 TD, helping the Ravens produce the NFL's sixth-ranked offense (378.8 ypg)... His 42.9 receiving ypg average ranks third on the Ravens' all-time rookie chart
- On 12/12/21 at Cle., posted a then-career-high 7 receptions for 103 yards, marking his first-career 100-yard outing... Made a 30-plus-yard grab on both of Baltimore's TD drives

- Following the 2020 murder of George Floyd, changed his jersey number from 13 to 0, which he explained represented zero tolerance for racism... Now wears No. 7, which is his mother's favorite number... Wore No. 12 as a rookie in 2021
- Is committed to using his NFL platform to advocate for social justice reform and to help end racism
- Looks up to and tries to emulate his game after NFL wideouts Odell Beckham Jr. and D.K. Metcalf

2025: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 13/12)

- Appeared in 13 games (12 starts), totaling 19 receptions for 224 yards and 2 receiving TDs... Contributed to an offense that ranked seventh in yards per play (5.8) and 11th in points per game (24.9)
- Registered 63 receiving yards and 1 TD on 5 receptions (12.6 avg.) vs. Det. (9/22)... Caught a 3-yard TD pass, his first TD of the season and the 14th of his career

2024: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/14, 2/2)

- Played in all 17 games (14 starts), tallying 45 receptions to go along with career highs in receiving yards (756) and receiving TDs (9)... Recorded three receiving TDs of at least 40 yards, tied for the most such scores in a season by a Raven since at least 2000... Teamed with TE Mark Andrews (11 receiving TDs) to form the first Ravens duo since WRs Derrick Alexander and Michael Jackson in 1996 to each record 9 or more receiving TDs in the same season... Contributed to an offense that ranked No. 1 in the NFL in yards per game (424.9), yards per play (6.8 – third-best single-season mark in NFL history) and red zone efficiency (74.2%) and No. 3 in points per game (30.5), while setting a franchise single-season record with 7,224 net yards
- Recorded 4 receptions for a playoff career-best 66 yards and 1 TD in the Divisional Playoff at Buf. (1/19/25)... With his 16-yard TD, he became the third player in Ravens history (Anquan Boldin & Dennis Pitta) to record a receiving TD in consecutive playoff games
- Tallied 2 receptions for 24 yards and 1 TD in the 28-14 Wild Card win vs. Pit. (1/11/25)... His 15-yard TD opened up the game's scoring and marked his first career postseason receiving score
- Tallied 5 catches for a game-high 76 yards and 1 TD in the 35-10 win vs. Cle. (1/4)... With a career-high 9 receiving TDs for the season, joined TE Mark Andrews (11) to form the second tandem (also WRs Derrick Alexander and Michael Jackson in 1996) in Ravens history to each register at least 9 receiving scores within a single season

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- Hauled in a go-ahead 14-yard TD reception in the second quarter to break an early tie in the 34-17 win vs. Pit. (12/21)...The score marked the second time in his career he has tallied a TD in consecutive games (Weeks 1-2, 2022)...With the receiving TD, his eighth of the season, teamed with TE Mark Andrews (9 receiving TDs) to form the first Ravens duo since WRs Derrick Alexander and Michael Jackson in 1996 to each record 8 or more receiving TDs in the same season
- Recorded 3 receptions for a team-high 80 yards and 2 TDs, marking the first multi-score game of his career, in the 35-14 win at NYG (12/15)...His 49-yard TD grab in the second quarter marked his third receiving score of at least 40 yards on the season, tied for the most such scores in a season by a Raven since 2000
- Recorded 2 receptions for 43 yards and 1 TD, a 40-yard score just before halftime with a DB draped all over him, in the MNF win at LAC (11/25)...His score capped an 8-play, 93-yard drive to give Baltimore a lead (14-10) that it never relinquished
- Posted 6 catches for 54 yards and 1 TD in the 35-34 win vs. Cin. (11/7)...Bateman's 5-yard TD grab on third-and-goal with 1:49 remaining in regulation proved to be the game-winning score in the divisional clash
- Recorded 4 receptions for a career-high 121 yards and 1 TD in the 41-31 win at TB (10/21)...Posted a 59-yard catch and run to the Buccaneers' 8-yard line for the second-longest reception of his career, and later tallied a 49-yard TD reception...Became the fourth Raven since 2000 and first since WR Marquise Brown (9/18/19 at Mia.) with multiple catches of at least 45 yards in the same game
- Tallied 4 receptions – all first downs – for 71 yards (17.8 ypc) in the 30-23 win vs. Was. (10/13), helping QB Lamar Jackson complete 20-of-26 passes for 323 yards and a 114.7 rating
- Registered 4 catches for 58 yards and 1 TD in the 41-38 OT win at Cin. (10/6)...Posted a 16-yard, third-down TD grab that put Baltimore ahead 14-7 in the second quarter
- Tallied 3 receptions for 28 yards and 1 TD in the 28-25 win at Dal. (9/22)...His TD grab marked his 100th career reception
- Tallied 2 receptions for 53 yards, including a 38-yard grab to the 10-yard line on Baltimore's final-drive comeback attempt, at KC (9/5)

2023: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 16/12, 2/2)

- Saw action in 16 games (12 starts), registering 32 catches for 367 yards and 1 TD...Was one of six Ravens to eclipse 300 receiving yards, as Baltimore tied (Cincinnati, Detroit, Green Bay and Washington) for the NFL's most players reaching that mark...Contributed to an offense that ranked fourth in scoring (28.4 ppg) and No. 6 in total yards (370.4 ypg)
- Made his postseason debut, registering 3 catches for 29 yards, including a team-long 21-yard grab in the 34-10 Divisional Playoff win vs. Hou. (1/20/24)
- Tallied 4 receptions for a season-high 54 yards in the No.-1 seed-clinching 56-19 win vs. Mia. (12/31)

- Posted his first TD of the season, a 10-yard grab to extend the Ravens' lead, in the 34-20 win vs. Cin. (11/16)
- Produced 2 catches for 34 yards, including a season-long 29-yarder, while adding another 18 yards on his first-career rush in the 31-24 win at Ari. (10/29)
- Tallied 3 receptions for 35 yards in the 25-9 season-opening win vs. Hou. (9/10)...Appeared in his first game since 10/27/22 at TB

2022: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 6/5, 0/0, INJURED RESERVE)

- Saw action in six games (five starts), before being placed on Injured Reserve (11/7) with a foot injury that sidelined him for the remainder of the season...Recorded 15 catches for 285 yards and 2 TDs...Registered a 55-yard TD grab and career-long 75-yard TD grab prior to his Week 8 injury
- Tallied 4 catches for a career-high 108 yards, including a career-long 75-yard TD reception, vs. Mia. (9/18)...Recorded his second-career 100-yard game and his second 50-yard TD in as many weeks (9/11 at NYJ), becoming the first Raven in franchise history to post a TD reception of that distance in each of the team's first two games of a season
- Reeled in a career-long 55-yard TD grab to put Baltimore ahead 23-3 in the third quarter of its 24-9 season-opening victory at NYJ (9/11)

2021: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 12/4)

- Saw action in 12 games (four starts) during his rookie campaign after missing the first five weeks of the season with a groin injury...Totaled 46 receptions for 515 yards and 1 TD, helping the Ravens produce the NFL's sixth-ranked offense (378.8 ypg)...His 42.9 receiving ypg average ranks third on the Ravens' all-time rookie chart, trailing only Torrey Smith's 52.6 ypg average in 2011
- Posted 58 yards on 7 receptions, tying his single-game career high in catches, vs. LAR (1/2/22)
- Registered 4 catches for 26 yards and his first-career touchdown at Cin. (12/26)...His 37 receptions and 25 first down grabs mark the most by a Ravens' rookie through the first 10 games of a career
- Posted a career-high 7 receptions for 103 yards, marking his first-career 100-yard outing, at Cle. (12/12)...Made a 30-plus-yard grab on both of Baltimore's TD drives
- Caught all 4 of his targets for 31 yards in the 16-10 win vs. Cle. (11/28)...Surpassed Marquise Brown (2018) for the most receptions (25) and first down grabs (18) by a Raven through the first six games of a career
- Caught 6 passes for a team-high 80 yards, including 4 first-down grabs, at Mia. (11/11)...Bateman's 15 first-down receptions are the most by a rookie Raven through four career games, while his 18 total receptions tied (Marquise Brown – 2019) for the most
- Caught 5 passes for 52 yards, with 4 first-down receptions, in the 34-31 OT win vs. Min. (11/7)...His 11 first down grabs (on 12 overall receptions) are the most by a Raven through three career games in franchise history

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- Recorded a then-career-high 80 receiving yards on 3 catches, including a 35-yarder, vs. Cin. (10/24)...All of his receptions yielded first downs and were 20-plus yard gains
- Made his NFL debut, finishing with 4 catches for 29 yards in the 34-6 win vs. LAC (10/17)

— COLLEGE —

- Recorded 147 receptions for 2,395 yards (sixth-highest career totals in Minnesota history) and 19 TDs (fifth in school history)...Averaged 77.3 receiving yards per game and a 16.3 yards-per-catch clip during his 31-game career...Posted 10 100-yard receiving games, which stand as the fourth most in Minnesota history...Caught at least one pass in all 31 games in which he played, the fifth-longest streak in school history
- In 2019, when he finished as a Biletnikoff Award (nation's top WR) finalist, registered 60 catches for 1,219 yards (second most in a Minnesota season and a Gophers' sophomore record)...Also tallied a career-high 11 receiving TDs in 2019, tying for the third most by a Gopher in a single season and marking a sophomore record
