### — CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Became the youngest player (age 27) in NFL history to reach 1,000 career tackles, while also becoming the sixth NFL player to record four or more seasons with 150-plus tackles
- Became the first NFL player since at least 2008 to record at least 15 tackles, 3 TFL and 1 defensive TD in a game (vs. Cle. 9/14/25)
- Started all 15 games in which he appeared in 2025, recording a team-high 130 tackles (76 solo), 5 TFL, 3 PD, 4 QBHs and a 63-yard FR-TD, en route to his fourth-consecutive Pro Bowl nod...Became the first NFL player since at least 2008 to record at least 15 tackles, 3 TFL and 1 defensive TD in a game (vs. Cle. 9/14/25), earning AFC Defensive Player of the Week for Week 2...Is the fourth NFL defender (also Bobby Wagner, Luke Kuechly & Chris Spielman) since at least 2000 to record 100+ tackles in each of his first eight seasons...Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 3 in defensive total rush EPA (52.3), No. 5 in goal-to-go defense (64.7%) and No. 6 in red zone TD efficiency (50.8%)

- Started in all 16 games in which he appeared in 2024, recording a team-high 154 tackles (81 solo), 4 TFL, 1.5 sacks, 1 INT, 4 PD, 1 FF and 1 FR, en route to his third-consecutive Pro Bowl nod...At age 27, he became the youngest player in NFL history to reach 1,000 career tackles, while also becoming the sixth player in league history to record four or more seasons with at least 150 tackles...Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 1 against the run (80.1 ypg), No. 2 in sacks (54) and No. 5 (tied) in yards per play allowed (5.2)
- Started all 16 games in which he appeared for Baltimore in 2023, recording a team-high 158 tackles, 5 TFL, 1.5 sacks, 5 QBHs, 1 INT, 1 FF and 8 PD, en route to his second-career Pro Bowl nod and first-team All-Pro honors...Became just the third NFL player to register at least 100 tackles and 1 INT in each of the first six seasons of a career...Teamed up with ILB Patrick Queen (133) to become the first duo in Ravens history to post 130+ tackles each in a season...Helped the Ravens' defense become the first unit in NFL history to lead the league in scoring (16.5), sacks (60) and takeaways (31)
- In 2022, started the final nine contests for Baltimore after being acquired via trade on 11/1, registering 86 tackles, 7 TFL, 2 sacks and 1 INT, en route to his first-career Pro Bowl nod and a first-team All-Pro selection...Helped Baltimore's defense rank in the Top 5 in four categories: No. 3 in scoring (18.5 ppg), No. 3 in red zone TD% (46.4), No. 3 in rushing (92.1 ypg) and No. 4 in third-down efficiency (34.9%)...Finished with 169 total tackles on the season between Baltimore (86) and Chicago (83), ranking as the NFL's third most, becoming the first player since at least 2000 to record 75+ tackles with multiple teams
- Became the first player since Hall of Famer Ray Lewis (1996-2000) with at least 100 tackles, 2 sacks and 1 INT in each of the first five years of a career (2018-22)...Is also the first player since Lewis (2000-01) with at least 300 tackles and 30 TFL in a two-year span (2020-21)
- Since his 2018 NFL arrival, Smith led a Bears' defensive unit that ranked No. 3 overall (328.3 ypg), No. 4 against the pass (212.8 ypg) and No. 4 in scoring (21.1 ppg)
- Started all 17 games in 2021, totaling 163 tackles (95 solo), 12 TFL, 3 sacks and his first-career pick-6 (53 yards), en route to earning second-team All-Pro honors...Led a defense that finished as the NFL's sixth overall unit (316.7 ypg)
- Started all 16 contests in 2020, posting 139 tackles (98 solo), including a career-high 18 TFL, while adding 4 sacks, 7 PD, 2 INTs, 1 FF and 1 FR, en route to garnering second-team All-Pro honors...Finished as the season's only NFL defender to record at least 100 tackles and 10 TFL with multiple sacks and multiple INTs...His 18 TFL were also the NFL's second most, trailing only T.J. Watt (23)

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- In 2019, started all 12 games in which he appeared, posting 100 tackles (65 solo), 5 TFL, 2 sacks, 2 PD and 1 INT for the No. 9 rush (102.0 ypg) and pass defense (221.9 ypg)
- Appeared in all 16 games (14 starts) as a rookie in 2018, tallying 121 tackles (89 solo), 8 TFL, a career-high 5 sacks, 5 PD and 1 INT for a Chicago defense that ranked No. 1 against the run (80.0 ypg) and No. 7 against the pass (219.7 ypg)...Is one of seven players in NFL history to record at least 100 tackles and 5 sacks in a rookie campaign (Shaquille Leonard – 2018; David Harris – 2007; Brian Urlacher – 2000; Duane Bickett – 1985; Reggie White – 1985 & Ricky Jackson – 1981)...Also appeared in the Wild Card Playoff vs. Phi. (1/6/19), totaling a team-high 7 tackles (6 solo) and 1 INT

## 2025: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 15/15)

- Started all 15 games in which he appeared, recording a team-high 130 tackles (76 solo), 5 TFL, 3 PD, 4 QBHs and a 63-yard FR-TD, en route to his fourth-consecutive Pro Bowl nod...Became the first NFL player since at least 2008 to record at least 15 tackles, 3 TFL and 1 defensive TD in a game (vs. Cle. 9/14/25), earning AFC Defensive Player of the Week for Week 2...Is the fourth NFL defender (also Bobby Wagner, Luke Kuechly & Chris Spielman) since at least 2000 to record 100+ tackles in each of his first eight seasons...Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 3 in defensive total rush EPA (52.3), No. 5 in goal-to-go defense (64.7%) and No. 6 in red zone TD efficiency (50.8%)
- Posted a team-high 10 tackles (8 solo) vs. NE (12/21), helping limit the Patriots to 4-of-12 (33.3%) on third down
- Registered a game-high 14 tackles (8 solo) in the 24-0 victory at Cin. (12/14), helping produce Baltimore's 15th shutout in franchise history and hold the Bengals to 3-of-15 (20%) on third down
- Notched a team-high 10 tackles (4 solo), including 1 TFL, vs. Pit. (12/7), becoming the fourth NFL defender (also Bobby Wagner, Luke Kuechly & Chris Spielman) since at least 2000 to record 100+ tackles in each of their first eight seasons
- Recorded a team-high 11 tackles (3 solo) vs. Cin. (11/27), helping limit the Bengals to 1-of-6 (17%) in red zone TD efficiency
- Tallied a team-high 11 tackles (6 solo) in the 23-10 victory vs. NYJ (11/23)

- Registered 4 tackles (2 solo) and 1 PD in the 23-16 victory at Cle. (11/16), helping hold the Browns to 2-of-14 (14.3%) on third down and 0 offensive TDs
- Recorded 6 tackles (3 solo) and 1 PD in the 27-19 victory at Min. (11/9), contributing to the defense's 13 PD, which are tied for the fourth most in single-game franchise history
- Posted a game-high 12 tackles (9 solo) and 1 PD in the 28-6 victory at Mia. (10/30), helping limit the Dolphins to 2-of-12 (17%) on third down and 0-of-3 (0%) in red zone TD efficiency
- Recorded 12 tackles (7 solo) vs. Chi. (10/26), marking 55 career games with 10+ tackles since entering the league in 2018, ranking as the NFL's most
- Registered 15 tackles (8 solo) in the 41-17 victory vs. Cle. (9/14), also posting a career-high-tying 3 TFL, 2 QBHs and a 63-yard FR-TD...Became the first NFL player since at least 2008 to record at least 15 tackles, 3 TFL and 1 defensive TD in a game
- Logged 10 tackles (8 solo) in the season opener at Buf. (9/7), marking his third time collecting at least 10 tackles in a Week 1 game

## 2024: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 16/16, 2/2)

- Started in all 16 games in which he appeared, recording a team-high 154 tackles (81 solo), 4 TFL, 1.5 sacks, 1 INT, 4 PD, 1 FF and 1 FR, en route to his third-consecutive Pro Bowl nod...At age 27, he became the youngest player in NFL history to reach 1,000 career tackles, while also becoming the sixth player in league history to record four or more seasons with at least 150 tackles...Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 1 against the run (80.1 ypg), No. 2 in sacks (54) and No. 5 (tied) in yards per play allowed (5.2)
- Logged 8 tackles (3 solo) in the Divisional Playoff at Buf. (1/19/25), helping limit the Bills to 126 passing yards
- Totaled 5 tackles (3 solo) in the 28-14 Wild Card win vs. Pit. (1/11/25), helping limit the Steelers to just 29 rushing yards – the third fewest ever allowed by the Ravens in a postseason game
- Tallied a game-high 10 tackles in the 35-10 win vs. Cle. (1/4), helping limit the Browns to just 230 total yards (56 rushing & 183 passing) and 4-of-12 (33%) on third down...Became the youngest player in NFL history (27 years old) to reach 1,000 career tackles
- Recorded a team-high 8 tackles (7 solo), including a third-quarter sack (0 yards), in the 31-2 win at Hou. (12/25)...Baltimore's defense shut out the Texans, limiting them to just 211 total yards (58 rushing & 153 passing) and 4-of-15 (26.7%) on third down
- Recorded a game-high 10 tackles (5 solo) in the 34-17 win vs. Pit. (12/21), helping the defense limit the Steelers to 198 passing yards and 4-of-10 (40%) on third down
- Posted a team-high 11 tackles (2 solo), including a half-sack (CB Marlon Humphrey), vs. Phi. (12/1), marking his 50th career double-digit tackle game

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- Logged a game-high 13 tackles (8 solo), including 2 TFL, at Pit. (11/17), helping limit the Steelers to 4-of-16 (25%) on third down and 0-of-4 (0%) in red zone TD efficiency
- Registered a game-high 12 tackles (6 solo) and 1 FR (forced by CB Marlon Humphrey), which led to a Ravens' TD on the ensuing offensive possession, in the 35-34 win vs. Cin. (11/7)
- Tallied a game-high 18 tackles (11 solo) and 1 FF in the 41-31 win at TB (10/21), marking his seventh-career game with at least 15 tackles... Baltimore's defense limited the Buccaneers to a 1-of-3 (33.3%) red zone TD efficiency
- Notched 7 tackles (5 solo) in the 30-23 victory vs. Was. (10/13), contributing to a unit that limited the Commanders to 52 rushing yards and 4-of-12 (33.3%) on third down
- Collected a game-high 14 tackles (7 solo) in the 41-38 OT win at Cin. (10/6), contributing to a unit that limited Cincinnati to 71 rushing yards
- Tallied 6 tackles (2 solo) in the 35-10 win vs. Buf. (9/29)... Baltimore's defense held Buffalo to a season-low 236 total yards (81 rushing & 155 passing) and 3-of-13 (23.1%) on third down
- Tallied 11 tackles (7 solo) and 1 PD in the 28-25 win at Dal. (9/22), marking the 45th double-digit tackle performance of his career, which surpassed LB Luke Kuechly for the most such outings in a player's first seven seasons of a post-2000 career
- Posted a team-high 11 tackles (4 solo) and 1 PD vs. LV (9/15), helping limit the Raiders to the 12th-fewest rushing yards (27, tied) in Ravens single-game history
- Posted a team-high 7 tackles (4 solo), 1 INT, 1 PD and 1 TFL at KC (9/5)... Became the 13th player in NFL history with at least 20 sacks and 10 INTs within the first 100 appearances in a career, reaching the mark in his 95th career game
- Posted 7 tackles (3 solo), 1 INT – a one-handed snag returned for 30 yards – and 2 PD in the 56-19 victory vs. Mia. (12/31)... Became just the third player in NFL history to record at least 100 tackles and 1 INT in each of the first six seasons of a career, joining LBs Luke Kuechly (2012-17) and Ray Lewis (1996-2001)
- Posted a team-best 8 tackles (2 solo) and 1 QBH in the 33-19 victory at SF (12/25)... Helped Baltimore tie a single-game franchise record with 5 INTs (10/14/07 vs. STL)
- Notched a team-high 10 tackles (5 solo), including 2 TFL, in the 37-31 OT victory vs. LAR (12/10)... His 2 third-quarter TFL helped the Ravens tie the franchise single-game record (6) for most TFLs in a quarter (10/26/17 vs. Mia.)
- Notched a team-high 8 tackles (5 solo), 1 PD and 1 FF – recovered by DE Brent Urban – in the 20-10 win at LAC (11/26)... Allowing just 279 total yards, Baltimore registered 4 total takeaways (3 FR & 1 INT), including 3 in the first half
- Collected 10 tackles (4 solo) in the 34-20 win vs. Cin. (11/16), helping limit the Bengals to 2-of-11 (18.2%) on third down
- Registered a career-high 21 tackles (14 solo) vs. Cle. (11/12), joining Hall of Fame LB Ray Lewis as the only Ravens in franchise history to record at least 20 tackles in a single game... Smith also became the first NFL defender in 2023 to record 20+ tackles in a game
- Tied (ILB Patrick Queen) for a team-high 11 tackles (8 solo) in the 31-24 victory at Ari. (10/29)
- Posted a team-high 8 tackles (5 solo) and 1 PD in the 38-6 win vs. Det. (10/22)... Baltimore's defense allowed fewer than 100 yards in the first half (97) for the fourth-consecutive game
- Registered 9 tackles (4 solo) in the 24-16 win at Ten. (10/15 in London)... Baltimore's defense permitted a season-low 1-of-9 (11.1%) on third down
- Posted a team-high 11 tackles (7 solo) and 1 PD at Pit. (10/8), becoming just one of three players to record 10-plus tackles in at least four games through the first five weeks of the 2023 season (LBs Zaire Franklin & T.J. Edwards)
- Registered a team-high 10 tackles (6 solo) and 2 PD in the 28-3 win at Cle. (10/1), contributing to a defense that allowed just 166 total yards (93 rushing and 73 passing) – its fewest since 12/2/18 at Atl. (131 yards)
- Was one of three Ravens (ILB Patrick Queen & DB Brandon Stephens) to record 10+ tackles (12), while adding a half-sack (OLB Jadeveon Clowney) on the first play of OT, vs. Ind. (9/24)
- Collected a game-high 16 tackles (8 solo), 1 QBH, 2 TFL and 1 sack (-11 yards) in the 25-9 season-opening victory vs. Hou. (9/10)... Contributed to a defense that permitted just 1 rushing first down, while limiting Houston to 7-of-18 (38.9%) on third down and 1-of-4 (25%) on fourth down... His 16 tackles are also the most by a Raven in a Kickoff Weekend in franchise history... Teamed with ILB Patrick Queen to become the first duo in Ravens history to each notch at least 10 tackles and 1 sack in the same game

## 2023: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 16/16, 2/2)

- Started all 16 games in which he appeared, recording a team-high 158 tackles, 5 TFL, 1.5 sacks, 5 QBHs, 1 INT, 1 FF and a career-best 8 PD, en route to his second-career Pro Bowl nod and first-team All-Pro honors... Became just the third player in NFL history to register at least 100 tackles and 1 INT in each of the first six seasons of a career... Teamed up with ILB Patrick Queen (133) to become the first duo in Ravens history to post 130+ tackles each in a season... Helped the Ravens' defense become the first unit in NFL history to lead the league in scoring (16.5), sacks (60) and takeaways (31)
- Collected a game-high 16 tackles (5 solo) – the most by a Raven in postseason play since Hall of Famer Ray Lewis (17 at Den., 1/12/13) – and 1 QBH in the AFC Championship vs. KC (1/28/24)... His 10 tackles (3 solo) in the first half marked the most by a Raven in any half of a postseason game in franchise history
- Registered a team-high 7 tackles (5 solo), including 2 TFL, for a Ravens' defense that allowed just 3 points and 213 total yards (38 rushing & 175 passing) in the Divisional Playoff victory vs. Hou. (1/20/24)

## 2022: (BALTIMORE RAVENS / CHICAGO BEARS – 17/17, 1/1)

- Started the final nine contests for Baltimore after being acquired via trade on 11/1, registering 86 tackles, 7 TFL, 2 sacks, and 1 INT, en route to his first-career Pro Bowl nod and a first-team All-Pro selection... Helped Baltimore's defense rank in the Top 5 in four categories: No. 3 in points allowed per game (18.5), No. 3 in defensive red zone TD% (46.4), No. 3 in rushing yards per game (92.1) and No. 4 in third-down efficiency (34.9%)... Finished with 169 total tackles on the season between Baltimore (86) and Chicago (83), ranking as the NFL's third most, becoming the first player since at least 2000 to record 75+ tackles with multiple teams... His 4.5 sacks marked the second most of his career, while he posted a personal-best 3 INTs
- Tallied 8 tackles (3 solo) in the Wild Card Playoff at Cin. (1/15), helping limit the Bengals to 234 total yards
- Registered a team-high 16 tackles (12 solo), his most as a Raven, at Cin. (1/8/23)
- Registered a team-high 14 tackles, including 1 TFL, in the 17-9 win vs. Atl. (12/24)... Recorded tackles on three consecutive plays as a part of Baltimore's fourth-quarter goal line stand that resulted in a turnover on downs... Baltimore's defense held Atlanta to 5-of-14 (35.7%) on third down and 1-of-4 (25%) on fourth down, while allowing zero touchdowns on four red zone trips
- Tallied a team-high 11 tackles (6 solo), including 1 TFL, at Cle. (12/17)... His 11 tackles tied his single-game high as a Raven... Baltimore's defense limited Cleveland to 5-of-15 (33.3%) on third down and a 1-of-4 (25%) red zone TD efficiency
- Recorded 5 tackles (3 solo), while adding 1 sack, 1 INT and 2 PD in the 16-14 win at Pit. (12/11)... Marked his third INT of the season (career high) and his first as a Raven, while also becoming the first NFL defender in 2022 with at least 4 sacks and 3 INTs... Baltimore's defense held Pittsburgh to 65 rushing yards (3.3 avg.), while adding 3 INTs to tie a season high (Week 3 at New England)
- Led the defense with 11 tackles, including 2 TFL, in the 10-9 win vs. Den. (12/4)... Baltimore's defense limited Denver to 272 total yards and 2-of-12 (16.7%) on third down, while conceding zero red zone trips for the first time all season
- Posted a team-high 8 tackles (5 solo) at Jax. (11/27)... Baltimore's defense limited Jacksonville to 38 rushing yards on 20 carries, marking its fourth-consecutive game holding opponents under 50 rushing yards
- Tallied 7 tackles (6 solo) and his first sack (-1 yard) as a Raven in the fourth quarter of the 13-3 win vs. Car. (11/20)... Baltimore's defense permitted season lows in points (3), total yards (205), rushing yards (36) and yards per play (3.8), while registering 4 sacks, 2 INTs and 1 FR
- Made his Ravens debut, registering 5 tackles (2 solo) in the 27-13 win at NO (11/7)... Baltimore's defense limited New Orleans – which entered the contest averaging 141.3 rushing ypg – to 48 yards rushing on 15 attempts (3.2 avg.)

- Spent Weeks 1-8 with Chicago prior to being acquired by Baltimore... Led the NFL in tackles (83 – 52 solo), while adding 2.5 sacks, 3 QBHs, 2 INTs and 3 PD after eight weeks... Was an integral part of a defense that ranked ninth in passing yards allowed per game (201.0) and eighth in the red zone (50.0%) over the first eight weeks of the season
- Posted a team-high 12 tackles (8 solo), 1 sack and 1 INT in the 33-14 win at NE (10/24)... Contributed to a Bears defense that permitted a season-low 70 rushing yards and 12 first downs, while limiting New England to 190 passing yards and registering a season-high 4 takeaways (3 INTs & 1 FR)
- Collected a team-high 12 tackles (9 solo) and 1 sack for a defense that permitted only 12 points, 86 passing yards and 14 first downs vs. Was. (10/13)... Chicago's 18.2% (2-of-11) defensive third-down efficiency marked its best single-game figure of the season
- Notched a team-high 10 tackles (8 solo) at NYG (10/2), leading a defense that permitted a season-low 9 completions, 71 passing yards and 44.3 passer rating
- Registered a season-high 16 tackles (6 solo), 2 TFL and 1 INT in the 23-20 win vs. Hou. (9/25)... His fourth-quarter INT with 1:13 remaining led to the game-winning 30-yard FG by Cairo Santos on the ensuing possession
- Tied (Nicholas Morrow) for a team-high in tackles (11) at GB (9/18)
- Posted 9 tackles, a half-sack, 1.5 TFL and 1 PD in the season-opening 19-10 win vs. SF (9/11)... Chicago permitted a season-low 46.4% completion percentage (13-of-28)

## 2021: (CHICAGO BEARS – 17/17)

- Started all 17 games, totaling 163 tackles (95 solo), 12 TFL, 3 sacks and his first-career pick-6 (53 yards), en route to earning second-team All-Pro honors... Led a defense that finished as the NFL's sixth overall unit (316.7 ypg)... His 163 tackles on the season ranked fifth in the league
- Posted a team-high 9 tackles (6 solo) and 2 TFL in the 29-3 win vs. NYG (1/2/22)... Led a unit that permitted a season-low 3 points, 4 completions, -6 passing yard and 9.1% opponent third-down conversion percentage (1-of-11)... The -6 passing yards allowed marked the fourth-fewest in Bears' history and its first negative output since 1985 (-22 yards – 11/24/85 vs. Atl.)
- Recorded 8 tackles (6 solo), including 1 TFL, in the 25-24 win at Sea. (12/26)... Chicago's defense limited Seattle to 3-of-10 (30%) on third down in the victory
- Registered a team-high 10 tackles (7 solo) for a defense that permitted 193 total yards and 61 through the air vs. Min. (12/20)
- Tied (DBs Eddie Jackson and Artie Burns) for the team high in tackles (9) at GB (12/12)
- Recorded a team-high 8 tackles (4 solo), including 1 TFL, for a defense that permitted only 120 passing yards vs. Ari. (12/5)
- Posted a career-high 17 tackles (13 solo), including 2 TFL, vs. Bal. (11/21)... The Bears' defense posted a 2021 single-game high in sacks (6)

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- Registered a team-high 12 tackles (6 solo), including 2 TFL and 1 sack, at Pit. (11/8)
- Posted 6 tackles (5 solo), including 1 TFL, vs. SF (10/31)
- Recorded a team-high 14 tackles (8 solo), 1 TFL and 1 PD at TB (10/24), marking his fifth-consecutive game with double-digit tackles...His third-down stop behind the line of scrimmage forced a Tampa Bay punt
- Tallied a team-high 12 tackles (6 solo) vs. GB (10/17)...Chicago's defense held Green Bay to a season-low 169 passing yards.
