- Passed physical and removed from Physically Unable to Perform (PUP) list on 8/11/26
- Placed on the Reserve/Physically Unable to Perform (PUP) list on 7/25/26
- Signed a three-year contract extension (through 2028) with the Ravens on 12/11/25
- Travis Jones was selected by the Ravens in the third round (76th overall) of the 2022 NFL Draft

— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Started all 16 games in which he appeared in 2025, logging 47 tackles (20 solo), a team-high 5 sacks, 9 TFL (also a team high), 9 QBHs, 2 PD, 1 FF and 1 FR...Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 3 in defensive total rush EPA (52.3), No. 5 in goal-to-go defense (64.7%) and No. 6 in red zone TD efficiency (50.8%)
- Appeared in all 17 games (15 starts) for Baltimore in 2024, posting 42 tackles (22 solo), 4 TFL and 1 sack...Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 1 against the run (80.1 ypg) and No. 2 in both sacks (54) and fourth-down efficiency (42.9%)
- Played in all 17 games for Baltimore in 2023, notching 36 tackles, 4 TFL, 1.5 sacks, 5 QBHs and 2 PD...Helped the Ravens' defense become the first unit in NFL history to lead the league in scoring (16.5), sacks (60) and takeaways (31)
- Played in 15 games (three starts) during his rookie season in 2022, tallying 24 tackles, 1 TFL, 1 sack, 2 QBHs and 1 PD...Helped Baltimore's defense rank in the Top 5 in four categories: No. 3 in points allowed per game (18.5), No. 3 in defensive red zone TD% (46.4), No. 3 in rushing yards per game (92.1) and No. 4 in third-down efficiency (34.9%)
- Made his first-career start, posting 4 solo tackles, 2 QBHs and his first-career sack (-6 yards) on the defense's first play of the game at NYG (10/16/22)...Baltimore's defense limited the Giants – who entered the contest No. 2 in rushing yards per game (179.0) – to 83 yards on the ground, while permitting a season-low 3.8 yards per play

— PERSONAL —

- Several schools thought Jones should play on the offensive line, but UConn recruited him as a defensive tackle
- Models his game after DTs Fletcher Cox and Akiem Hicks

2025: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 16/16)

- Started all 16 games in which he appeared, logging 47 tackles (20 solo), a team-high 5 sacks, 9 TFL (also a team high), 9 QBHs, 2 PD, 1 FF and 1 FR...Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 3 in defensive total rush EPA (52.3), No. 5 in goal-to-go defense (64.7%) and No. 6 in red zone TD efficiency (50.8%)

- Tallied 4 tackles (1 solo), including 1.5 sacks (-7.5 yards), in the 41-24 victory at GB (12/27), helping limit the Packers to just 79 total rushing yards and 0-of-2 (0%) on fourth down
- Logged 4 tackles (2 solo), including 1 sack (-5 yards), in the 24-0 victory at Cin. (12/14), helping produce Baltimore's 15th shutout in franchise history and hold the Bengals to 3-of-15 (20%) on third down
- Tallied a career-high 6 tackles (1 solo), including 1 TFL, and his first-career FF/FR vs. Cin. (11/27), helping limit the Bengals to 1-of-6 (17%) in red zone TD efficiency
- Registered 5 tackles (2 solo), including 1 TFL, in the 23-10 victory vs. NYJ (11/23)
- Tallied 3 solo tackles, including 1 sack, and a career-high 2 PD in the 27-19 victory at Min. (11/9), contributing to the defense's 13 PD, which are tied for the fourth most in single-game franchise history
- Logged a career-tying best 5 tackles (2 solo), including a half-sack (-3 yards), in the 28-6 victory at Mia. (10/30), helping limit the Dolphins to 2-of-12 (17%) on third down and 0-of-3 (0%) in red zone TD efficiency
- Posted 3 tackles (2 solo) and 1 TFL at Buf. (9/7)

2024: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/15, 2/2)

- Appeared in all 17 games (15 starts), posting a career-high 42 tackles (22 solo), 4 TFL and 1 sack...Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 1 against the run (80.1 ypg), No. 2 in sacks (54) and No. 5 (tied) in yards per play allowed (5.2)
- Recorded 4 tackles (3 solo), including 1 TFL, vs. Phi. (12/1), helping the defense limit the Eagles to 252 total yards and 4-of-12 (33%) on third down
- Collected 4 tackles (3 solo), including 2 TFL, and a first-quarter sack (-11 yards) in the 30-23 victory vs. Was. (10/13), contributing to a unit that limited the Commanders to 52 rushing yards and 4-of-12 (33.3%) on third down
- Notched 4 tackles (1 solo) in the 35-10 win vs. Buf. (9/29)...Baltimore's defense held Buffalo to a season-low 236 total yards (81 rushing & 155 passing) and 3-of-13 (23.1%) on third down
- Registered a career-high-tying 4 solo tackles in the 28-25 win at Dal. (9/22), helping limit Dallas to 51 rushing yards
- Tallied 3 tackles (2 solo), including 1 TFL, vs. LV (9/15)...Helped limit the Raiders to just 27 rushing yards, tied for the 12th fewest in Ravens single-game history

2023: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/0, 2/0)

- Played in all 17 games, notching 36 tackles, 4 TFL, 1.5 sacks, 5 QBHs and 2 PD...Helped the Ravens' defense become the first unit in NFL history to lead the league in scoring (16.5), sacks (60) and takeaways (31)

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— COLLEGE —

- Registered 2 total tackles, 1 QBH (forcing a Brock Purdy INT by Patrick Queen) and 1 PD in the 33-19 victory at SF (12/25)...Baltimore tied a single-game franchise record with 5 INTs (10/14/07 vs. STL)
- Posted 2 tackles, including his first full sack (-4 yards) of the season, and 2 QBHs in the 37-31 OT victory vs. LAR (12/10)

2022: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 15/3, 1/0)

- Played in 15 games (three starts) during his rookie season, tallying 24 tackles, 1 TFL, 1 sack, 2 QBHs and 1 PD...Helped Baltimore's defense rank in the Top 5 in four categories: No. 3 in points allowed per game (18.5), No. 3 in defensive red zone TD% (46.4), No. 3 in rushing yards per game (92.1) and No. 4 in third-down efficiency (34.9%)
- Produced 4 tackles in the 17-9 win vs. Atl. (12/24)... Baltimore's defense held Atlanta to 5-of-14 (35.7%) on third down and 1-of-4 (25%) on fourth down, while allowing zero touchdowns on four red zone trips
- Made his first-career start, posting 4 solo tackles, 2 QBHs and his first-career sack (-6 yards) on the defense's first play of the game at NYG (10/16)...Baltimore's defense limited the Giants – who entered the contest No. 2 in rushing yards per game (179.0) – to 83 yards on the ground, while permitting a season-low 3.8 yards per play
- Made his NFL debut in the 37-26 win at NE (9/25), seeing action on both defense and special teams and notching 1 tackle...Baltimore's defense forced 4 turnovers (3 in the fourth quarter) for the first time since 2017 (12/17 at Cle.) and limited New England to 2-of-9 (22.2%) on third down

- Was a three-year starter (2018-19, 21) at Connecticut who saw action in 35 games (32 starts), posting 133 tackles (47 solo), 19 TFL, 8.5 sacks and 1 FR throughout his career...Named the Senior Bowl's top defensive tackle
- Served as a team captain in 2021 following a 21-month layoff due to COVID-19 concerns...Started all 11 games in which he saw action, tallying a career-high 47 tackles (16 solo), 7.5 TFL and team-best 4.5 sacks
- In 2019, started 11 of 12 games in which he saw action, posting 40 tackles (14 solo), 6 TFL, 3.5 sacks and 1 FR
- Played in all 12 games (10 starts) as a freshman in 2018, recording 46 tackles (17 solo), 5.5 TFL and a half-sack

— HIGH SCHOOL —

- Prepped at Wilbur Cross (New Haven, CT) HS, where he was an integral member of the Governors' OL/DL
- As a senior in 2017, saw action at left and right OT and earned multiple first-team All-State honors...As a standout defensive lineman, posted 61 tackles, 7 sacks and 2 FFs
- As a junior in 2016, saw action primarily at center and tackle and was a standout defensive lineman...Earned second-team All-State honors and helped the team rush for more than 1,500 yards, while finishing with 45 tackles and 1 sack
- Spent most of his freshman year (2014) on junior varsity before becoming a two-way starter on varsity as a sophomore (2015)
