- Trenton Simpson was selected by the Ravens in the third round (86th overall) of the 2023 NFL Draft

— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Played in all 17 games (13 starts) for the Ravens in 2024, setting career highs in tackles (70), TFL (5), sacks (1.5) and PD (4), also posting 1 FR and adding 3 ST tackles...Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 1 against the run (80.1 ypg) and No. 2 in both sacks (54) and fourth-down efficiency (42.9%)
- Appeared in 15 games, primarily on special teams, during his rookie campaign with Baltimore in 2023, notching 7 tackles, 2 TFL and 1 sack on defense, while adding 6 tackles on special teams...Helped the Ravens' defense become the first unit in NFL history to lead the league in scoring (16.5), sacks (60) and takeaways (31)

— PERSONAL —

- Father is Timothy Simpson, decorated Command Sergeant Major in the U.S. Army Rangers who was deployed 17 times during a 26-year career in service
- Was born on Fort Benning, a military base in Georgia, on June 14, 2001, sharing a birthday with the same day the U.S. Army was founded (1775)...Grew up a fixture on military bases when his father was stateside
- Credits his father's military background for his discipline
- Was given the honor of running the American Flag down the hill at Clemson, sharing that special moment with his father prior to the Tigers' 44-7 win over UConn on Military Appreciation Day (11/13/22)
- Was teammates with Philadelphia Eagles DT Jordan Davis at Mallard Creek (Charlotte, NC) HS
- Told his mother at 3 years old he wanted to play in the NFL
- Originally committed to Auburn before ultimately choosing his dream school, Clemson University
- Earned his degree in sports communications in three years (2020-22) from Clemson

2025: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/6)

- Played all 17 games (six starts), recording 55 tackles (30 solo), 2.5 sacks, 4 TFL, 4 QBHs and 1 PD, while adding 11 ST tackles (4 solo)...Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 3 in defensive total rush EPA (52.3), No. 5 in goal-to-go defense (64.7%) and No. 6 in red zone TD efficiency (50.8%)
- Collected 8 tackles (5 solo) at Pit. (1/4/26)
- Tallied 7 tackles (6 solo), including 2 TFL and 1 sack (-1 yard), vs. NE (12/21), helping limit the Patriots to 4-of-12 (33.3%) on third down

- Registered 7 tackles (4 solo) in the 24-0 victory at Cin. (12/14), helping produce Baltimore's 15th shutout in franchise history and hold the Bengals to 3-of-15 (20%) on third down
- Posted 9 tackles (4 solo), including a half-sack (-2.5 yards), vs. LAR (10/12), helping limit the Rams' offense to a season-low 241 net yards
- Logged a career-best 10 tackles (4 solo), including 1 sack (-9 yards), vs. Hou. (10/5)

2024: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/13, 2/0)

- Played in all 17 games (13 starts), setting career highs in tackles (70), TFL (5), sacks (1.5) and PD (4), also posting 1 FR and adding 3 ST tackles...Helped Baltimore's defense rank No. 1 against the run (80.1 ypg) and No. 2 in both sacks (54) and fourth-down efficiency (42.9%)
- Logged 7 tackles (4 solo) in the 35-34 win vs. Cin. (11/7)
- Posted a career-high 9 tackles (7 solo), including 2 TFL and 1 sack (-13 yards), as well as 1 PD in the 41-10 win vs. Den. (11/3), helping the defense limit Denver to a 1-of-4 (25%) red zone TD efficiency
- Totaled 4 solo tackles, including 1 TFL, and 1 FR (forced by S Kyle Hamilton) at Cle. (10/27)...The FR led to a QB Lamar Jackson-to-WR Nelson Agholor 11-yard TD on the Ravens' ensuing drive
- Recorded a career-high 8 tackles (5 solo) and 1 TFL in the 41-31 win at TB (10/21)...Baltimore's defense limited the Buccaneers to a 1-of-3 (33.3%) red zone TD efficiency
- Posted 7 tackles (2 solo), 2 QBHs, 1 TFL and 1 PD in the 41-38 OT win at Cin. (10/6), contributing to a unit that limited Cincinnati to 71 rushing yards
- Posted 5 total tackles in the 35-10 win vs. Buf. (9/29)...Baltimore's defense held Buffalo to a season-low 236 total yards (81 rushing & 155 passing) and 3-of-13 (23.1%) on third down
- Recorded 4 tackles (2 solo) and 1 PD in the 28-25 win at Dal. (9/22), helping the defense limit the Cowboys to just 51 rushing yards
- Notched 5 tackles (3 solo) vs. LV (9/15)...Helped limit the Raiders to just 27 rushing yards, tied for the 12th fewest in Ravens single-game history
- Posted a career-high tying 5 tackles (2 solo), 1 PD and a half-sack in his first career start at KC (9/5)...Baltimore's defense limited the Chiefs to just 72 yards rushing and 1-of-3 (33%) in the red zone

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2023: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 15/0, 2/0)

- Appeared in 15 games, primarily on special teams, during his rookie season, posting 7 tackles, 2 TFL and 1 sack on defense, adding 6 tackles on special teams...Helped the Ravens' defense become the first unit in NFL history to lead the league in scoring (16.5), sacks (60) and takeaways (31)
- Recorded a career-high 5 tackles (4 solo), including his first-career sack (-6 yards) and 2 TFL, vs. Pit. (1/6)...Became the fourth Ravens rookie (also S Kyle Hamilton – 12/17/22 at Cle.; LB Patrick Queen – 12/20/20 vs. Jax. & LB C.J. Mosley – 11/24/14 at NO) since at least 2000 (when data became available) to register at least 5 tackles, 2 TFL and 1 sack in a single game
- Notched 1 tackle and his first FR (10-yard return) in the fourth quarter in the 56-19 victory vs. Mia. (12/31)
- Made his NFL debut, seeing action on special teams in the 25-9 season-opening victory vs. Hou. (9/10)

— COLLEGE —

- Appeared in 37 games (27 starts) for Clemson during his three-year playing career (2020-22), posting 187 tackles (117 solo), 22.5 TFL, 12.5 sacks, 3 FFs and 6 PD
- College honors include: third-team All-ACC (2022); Butkus Award (nation's top LB) semifinalist (2022); Finalist for the Lott IMPACT Trophy (2022), which recognizes the student-athlete who best exhibits the characteristics of Pro Football Hall of Famer Ronnie Lott by making an IMPACT on and off the field; Two-time All-ACC Academic Honor Roll (2021-22)
- Named a Butkus Award semifinalist in 2022 and earned third-team All-ACC honors after registering 77 tackles (51 solo), 4 TFL, 2.5 sacks, 2 FFs and 3 PD in 12 starts for a Clemson defense that finished ranked 28th nationally (334.4 ypg)...Helped lead the Tigers to an 11-3 record, including an undefeated mark (8-0) in ACC play...Clemson won the ACC Championship before falling to Tennessee, 31-14, in the Orange Bowl, which Simpson didn't participate in (ankle)

- Appeared in 13 games (12 starts) in 2021, tallying a career-high 78 tackles (50 solo), 12 TFL and 6 sacks, while adding 3 PD for a Clemson defense that permitted the nation's second-fewest points per game (14.8) and eighth-fewest yards per game (306.3)...The Tigers finished 10-3, defeating Iowa State, 20-13, in the Cheez-It Bowl and ranking No. 14 in the AP Top 25
- Saw action in 12 games (three starts) as a freshman in 2020, posting 32 tackles (16 solo), 6.5 TFL, 4 sacks and 1 FF for a Clemson defense that ranked 14th in the nation (326.8 ypg), permitting the fourth-fewest first downs per game (16.0) and seventh-fewest yards per rush (7.1)...The Tigers finished 10-2, winning their sixth-consecutive ACC title before falling to Ohio State, 49-28, in the Sugar Bowl (national semifinal) and earning the No. 3 spot in the final AP Top 25

— HIGH SCHOOL —

- Prepped at Mallard Creek (Charlotte, NC) HS, where he starred at both LB and RB
- Recorded 97 carries for 799 yards (8.2 avg.) and 7 TDs throughout his career
- Helped his team to a 10-1 record and No. 3 North Carolina ranking as a senior in 2019...Led the Mallard Creek defense with 20 sacks, while adding 44 carries for 371 yards and 6 TDs...Won the Arnold R. Solomon Award for North Carolina's High School Football Player of the Year and earned an invitation to the Under Armour All-American Game
- Rushed for 428 yards and 1 TD as a sophomore, helping Mallard Creek to a 14-1 record and the 2017 4AA state championship game
- Was a consensus five-star LB and four-star RB who was ranked as high as the No. 13 overall player, second-best LB in the nation and No. 1 player in the state of North Carolina
- Also lettered in basketball and track, setting a personal best in the 100 meters (11.15) as a junior
