— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Appeared in five games (including two starts when he lead Baltimore to victory) for the Ravens in 2025, completing 52-of-67 passes (77.6%) for 426 yards, 2 TDs and a passer rating of 103.1...Also added 151 rushing yards on 24 attempts
- Saw action in six games (four starts) in relief of QB Lamar Jackson (knee) in 2022, completing 75-of-112 passes for 658 yards, 2 TDs and 3 INTs, while adding 43 rush attempts for 137 yards and 1 TD...Completed 17-of-29 passes for 226 yards, 2 TDs and 1 INT (92.0 rating), while adding 9 rushes 54 yards, including a game-long 35-yarder, in the Wild Card Playoff at Cin. (1/15/23)...Became the 10th NFL QB since the 1970 merger to post at least 200 passing yards and 50 rushing yards in the first postseason start of a career, joining Josh Allen, Daunte Culpepper, Daniel Jones, Colin Kaepernick, Joe Montana, Cam Newton, Tim Tebow, Deshaun Watson & Steve Young

- Filled in for QB Lamar Jackson, who left the game due to injury (knee) at the end of the first quarter in the 10-9 win vs. Den. (12/4/22)...Completed 27-of-32 passes for 187 yards, with 1 INT, while adding a team-high 41 rushing yards on 10 carries...Led his second-career fourth quarter game-winning drive, completing 8-of-8 passes for 50 yards, while adding 12 rushing yards and a 2-yard rushing TD to help seal the victory...Became the first backup QB since at least 2000 (when data became available) to spark a 90+ yard drive that resulted in a game-winning TD in the final minute of regulation
- Saw action in seven games (four starts) in relief of QB Lamar Jackson in 2021, completing 122-of-188 passes for 1,081 yards, 3 TDs and 4 INTs (76.6 rating)...Added 294 rushing yards and 2 TDs on 47 carries (6.3 avg)...Was instrumental in helping Baltimore produce the NFL's sixth-ranked offense (378.8 ypg) and third-best rushing attack (145.8 ypg)
- On 12/12/21 at Cle., filled in for QB Lamar Jackson following his second-quarter departure (ankle – did not return), completing 27-of-38 passes for a career-high 270 yards and his first-career TD (99.7 rating), while adding 45 rushing yards on 6 carries
- Made his first NFL start in place of QB Lamar Jackson (illness), completing 26-of-36 passes for 219 yards, while adding 40 yards on the ground, in the 16-13 win at Chi. (11/21/21)...Led a five-play, 72-yard game-winning drive with 1:33 remaining in the fourth quarter to help Baltimore secure its first-ever victory in Chicago...Huntley joined Chase Daniel (2013) and Robert Griffin III (2012) as the only QBs in NFL history to eclipse 200 passing yards and 40 rushing yards, while completing at least 70% of their passes in their first NFL start.
- Played in two regular season games and one postseason contest as a rookie in 2020...Completed 3-of-5 passes for 15 yards, while adding 23 rushing yards on 10 carries...Also filled in for QB Lamar Jackson (concussion) in the fourth quarter of the AFC Divisional Playoff at Buf. (1/16/21), completing 7-of-13 passes for 60 yards, while adding 32 yards rushing on 3 attempts

— PERSONAL —

- Played against Ravens QB Lamar Jackson in high school...In a battle of unbeaten teams in 2014, the two star quarterbacks combined for 8 TDs...Huntley's Hallandale Chargers eventually secured the victory

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2025: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 5/2)

- Appeared in five games (including two starts when he led Baltimore to victory), completing 52-of-67 passes (77.6%) for 426 yards, 2 TDs and a passer rating of 103.1...Also added 151 rushing yards on 24 attempts
- Notched 107 yards and 1 TD on 16-of-20 passing (105.6 rating) and added 60 rushing yards on 8 attempts in Baltimore's 41-24 victory at GB (12/27)...Huntley has recorded a 100+ passer rating in each of his two starts this season (both wins)
- Finished with a career-best 116.9 passer rating, notching 186 yards, 1 TD and 0 INTs on 17-of-22 passing (77.3%) vs. Chi. (10/26)...Added 53 rushing yards on 8 carries on the ground (6.6 avg.)...The win marked Huntley's sixth victory as a starter – second over the Bears – and his first since 12/29/24 (vs. Cle.) while with Miami
- Completed 10-of-15 passes for 68 yards, while also rushing 3 times for 39 yards (13.0 avg.), after entering the game in the fourth quarter vs. LAR (10/12)

2024: (MIAMI DOLPHINS / BALTIMORE RAVENS – 5/5)

- Started in five games for the Dolphins, completing 86-of-133 passes for 829 yards and 3 TDs with 3 INTs (80.1 rating), while also adding 135 yards on the ground, after taking over for QB Skylar Thompson in Week 4 against the Titans...Also spent the first two weeks of the season on the Ravens' practice squad
- Completed 25-of-41 passes for 227 yards and 1 TD (63.8 rating) at NYJ (1/5/25)
- Completed 22-of-26 passes for 225 yards and 1 TD (115.5 rating) with 52 rushing yards on 7 carries in the 20-3 victory at Cle. (12/29)

2023: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 5/1, 0/0)

- Appeared in five games (one start), completing 21-of-37 passes for 203 yards and 3 TDs, posting a career-best 99.3 passer rating...Also added 55 rushing yards on 15 carries
- Started at QB in place of Lamar Jackson (rest), completing 15-of-28 passes for 146 yards and 1 TD, while adding 8 rushes for 40 yards, in the regular season finale vs. Pit. (1/6/24)

2022: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 6/4, 1/1)

- Saw action in six games (four starts) in relief of QB Lamar Jackson (knee), completing 75-of-112 passes for 658 yards, 2 TDs and 3 INTs, while adding 43 rush attempts for 137 yards and 1 TD
- Completed 17-of-29 passes for 226 yards, 2 TDs and 1 INT (92.0 rating), while adding 9 rushes 54 yards, including a game-long 35-yarder, in the Wild Card Playoff at Cin. (1/15/23)...Became the 10th NFL QB since the 1970 merger to post at least 200 passing yards and 50 rushing yards in the first postseason start of a career, joining Josh Allen, Daunte Culpepper, Daniel Jones, Colin Kaepernick, Joe Montana, Cam Newton, Tim Tebow, Deshaun Watson & Steve Young

- Completed 9-of-17 passes for 115 yards, 1 TD and a 94.0 rating in the 17-9 victory vs. Atl. (12/24)...Also added 28 rushing yards on 6 attempts and rushed for a successful two-point conversion to extend Baltimore's lead to 14-0...Connected with WR Sammy Watkins for his longest completion (40 yards) of the season
- Made his first start of the season in the 16-14 victory at Pit. (12/11), completing 8-of-12 passes for 88 yards, while adding 9 carries for 31 yards on the ground...Left the game (concussion) in the third quarter and did not return
- Filled in for QB Lamar Jackson, who left the game due to injury (knee) at the end of the first quarter in the 10-9 win vs. Den. (12/4)...Completed 27-of-32 passes for 187 yards, with 1 INT, while adding a team-high 41 rushing yards on 10 carries...Spearheaded his second-career fourth quarter game-winning drive, completing 8-of-8 passes for 50 yards, while adding 12 rushing yards and a 2-yard rushing TD to help seal the victory

2021: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 7/4)

- Saw action in seven games (four starts) in relief of QB Lamar Jackson, completing 122-of-188 passes for 1,081 yards, 3 TDs and 4 INTs (76.6 rating)...Added 294 rushing yards and 2 TDs on 47 carries (6.3 avg.)...Was instrumental in helping Baltimore produce the NFL's sixth-ranked offense (378.8 ypg) and third-best rushing attack (145.8 ypg)
- Completed 16-of-31 passes for 141 yards and 2 INTs, adding 12 carries for 72 yards in the season finale vs. Pit. (1/9/22)...Became the second quarterback in NFL history (joining Lamar Jackson) to record 40 rushing yards in each of the first four starts of an NFL career
- Completed 20-of-32 passes for 197 yards and 1 INT, while adding 54 rushing yards on 6 carries, vs. LAR (1/2/22)...Eclipsed 150 passing yards and 40 rushing yards in his fourth-consecutive appearance and third-straight start
- In his second-career start, completed 28-of-40 passes for 215 yards, 2 TDs and 0 INTs (99.5 rating), while also adding 2 rushing TDs (the first of his career) vs. GB (12/19)...Led Baltimore back from 14 down in the fourth quarter, setting up the Ravens' potential game-winning 2-point conversion attempt...Became one of seven NFL QBs since 1960 to throw for 200 yards/2 TDs and rush for 70 yards/2 TDs
- Filled in for QB Lamar Jackson following his second-quarter departure (ankle) at Cle. (12/12)...Completed 27-of-38 passes for a career-high 270 yards and his first-career TD (99.7 rating), while adding 45 rushing yards on 6 carries
- Made his first NFL start in place of QB Lamar Jackson (illness), completing 26-of-36 passes for 219 yards, while adding 40 rush yards, in the 16-13 win at Chi. (11/21)...Led a five-play, 72-yard game-winning drive with 1:33 remaining in the fourth quarter to help Baltimore secure its first-ever victory in Chicago...Huntley joined Chase Daniel (2013) and Robert Griffin III (2012) as the only QBs in NFL history to eclipse 200 passing yards and 40 rushing yards, while completing at least 70% of their passes, in their first NFL start.

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- Made his season debut in relief of QB Lamar Jackson in the fourth quarter, in the 34-6 win vs. LAC (10/17)...Tallied 3 carries for 10 yards to close out the game

2020: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 2/0, 1/0)

- Saw action in two regular season games as a rookie in relief of QB Lamar Jackson...Completed 3-of-5 passes for 15 yards, while adding 23 rushing yards on 10 carries...Also filled in for QB Lamar Jackson (concussion) in the fourth quarter of the AFC Divisional Playoff
- Completed 7-of-13 passes for 60 yards, while adding 32 yards rushing on 3 attempts, in relief of QB Lamar Jackson (concussion) in the Divisional Playoff at Buf. (1/16/21)
- Saw his first NFL action in relief of starter Lamar Jackson in the 40-14 win vs. Jax. (12/20)...Completed 2-of-4 passes for 7 yards, while adding 18 rushing yards on 4 carries before kneeling in victory formation

— COLLEGE —

- A first-team All-Pac-12 honoree in 2019, Huntley played in 37 career games (33 starts) for Utah...Was 23-10 as a starter, ranking third all time in career wins by a Utah QB
- Completed 574-of-854 passes for 7,351 yards, 46 TDs and 20 INTs, adding 1,146 rushing yards and 16 TDs...Set the school record for career completion percentage (67.2), while his 20 career 200-yard passing games rank fourth all time in Utah history...Was a two-time honorable mention Pac-12 All-Academic honoree (2017-18)
- During his 2019 senior season, was a finalist for the Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award and the Manning Award, in addition to being a semifinalist for the Walter Camp Player of the Year Award, the Davey O'Brien Award and the Lombardi Award...Was named Co-Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Year and earned first-team All-Conference honors...Started all 14 games, going 220-of-301 passing for 3,092 yards, 19 TDs and just 4 INTs...Added 290 rushing yards and 5 ground scores...Finished the season ranked second (Joe Burrow) in the FBS and first in the Pac-12 in completion percentage (73.1), fifth in the FBS and first in the Pac-12 in passing efficiency (177.6) and third in the FBS and first in the Pac-12 in yards per pass attempt (10.3)...Was a two-time Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week honoree

- As a junior in 2018, started nine games (6-3 record) before missing the last five with an injury...Was 150-of-234 passing for 1,788 yards, 12 TDs and 6 INTs...At the time of his injury, was the team's second-leading rusher with 304 yards and 4 TDs...Named Pac-12 Player of the Week for his 341 yards passing (22-of-29) and 4 TDs, along with 33 rushing yards and 1 TD, against USC
- As a sophomore in 2017, started 10 games (and missed three due to injury), going 6-4 en route to completing 199-of-312 passes for 2,411 yards, 15 TDs and 10 INTs...Ranked second on the team in rushing TDs (6) and rushing yards (537)...Posted career highs in both passing yards (341) and passing TDs (4) vs. San Jose State...Tallied a career-high 93 rushing yards vs. UCLA, while also throwing 4 TDs
- Played in four games as a true freshman (2016), going 5-of-7 passing for 60 yards...Added 9 rushes for 15 yards and 1 TD
- Graduated with a degree in sociology

— HIGH SCHOOL —

- While at Hallandale (Hallandale Beach, FL) HS, was named the 2015 Florida Gatorade Football Player of the Year, also garnering two-time (2014-15) All-Broward County honors at QB...Went 34-10 as a starter in four years, passing for 9,053 yards and 106 TDs
- Was 237-of-387 passing for 3,636 yards, 42 TDs and just 10 INTs as a senior, leading Hallandale to a 10-3 record and 5A regional finals appearance for the first time in school history...Set a state record with 71 pass attempts against St. Thomas Aquinas, throwing for 468 yards in the game
