— KEY TRANSACTIONS —

- Tyler Loop was selected by the Ravens in the sixth round (186th overall) of the 2025 NFL Draft...Was the second of five Ravens draft picks in the round

— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Connected on 30-of-34 FGAs (88.2%) and 44-of-46 PATs (95.7%) as a rookie in 2025...Recorded a franchise-rookie-record 134 points (tied for the NFL’s seventh most in 2025)

— PERSONAL —

- Wasn’t originally interested in playing football as a youth, but enjoyed playing soccer and had a strong leg, so his father, Steve, persuaded him to try kicking
- Became the first Arizona kicker drafted since Nick Folk in 2007, who Loop mentions as a kicker he has looked up to, and also the first kicker ever drafted by the Ravens
- Graduated with a marketing degree at Eller School of Management at Arizona
- Participated in the Hula Bowl, an All-Star showcase for Draft-eligible players in 2024
- Has attended various Kohl’s Kicking camps and showcases throughout high school and college
- Got engaged to his fiancée, Julia, in March of 2025...The two met at UA and went to “Golf N’ Stuff” for their first date
- Has plans of “going into some sort of ministry” when he’s done playing football and notes his strong Christian faith
- Has one brother, Andrew, and one sister, Sarah

2025: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17)

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- Connected on 4-of-5 FGAs (44, 30, 28 & 22 yards) in the 27-19 win at Min. (11/9), scoring a team-high 13 points
- Connected on 2-of-2 FGAs at KC (9/28), totaling 7-of-7 on the season, which is the highest FG% by a Ravens kicker through the first four games of a career
- In his NFL debut, connected on 2-of-2 FGAs (52 & 49 yards) at Buf. (9/7)...His 52-yard FG marks the fourth-longest by a Ravens rookie in team history

— COLLEGE —

- Appeared in 50 games, as both a place kicker and punter, during his five-year career (2020-24) at Arizona...Owns an 83.8 career FG % (67-of-80), the highest in Arizona program history, and a 98.4 career PAT % (126-of-128), which is tied for third in program history...His 83.8 career FG % also ranked 39th in college football history at the time
- Also owns school program records in most consecutive games with a FG (22) and most consecutive PAT kicks made (118), while ranking third in all-time scoring at Arizona (327), behind K Max Sendejas (360) and RB Art Luppino (337)
- His 62-yard FG vs. Houston (11/15/24) marked a career long, Arizona school record and tied for the fourth-longest FG in FBS since 1996

— HIGH SCHOOL —

- Attended Lovejoy (Lucas, TX) HS, where he lettered three years in football (as a kicker/punter), two years in soccer (forward) and one year in track and field (high jump, 100-meter and 200-meter)
- Ranked No. 8 kicker in the country by Kohl’s Kicking out of high school
